There are cultural spaces scattered throughout the airport where international travelers can not only see, but also experience first hand the outstanding traditional culture of Korea. Korean Cultural Street is one such place, a hidden recreation area in Terminal 1, open to all visitors. The nature and cultural heritage of Korea are exhibited here through exhibitions and videos. The Korean Cultural Street also has large recreational areas decorated in traditional Korean style through the mangyeongjeong and Biseonru pavilions. Biseonru Pavilion, in particular, offers a great view of the interior of the airport, as well as planes coming and others on the tarmac outside. Both Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 have Korean centers of traditional culture experience, perfect for making last minute souvenirs or watching performances to pass the time. Crafts use a variety of traditional materials from hanji (traditional Korean paper) to najoon (pearl) and minhwa (folk painting). All programs are free for foreign visitors. Performances include traditional instruments such as haegeum (two-way vertical violin), janggu (two-headed hourglass drum) and piri (bamboo oboe). Terminal 2 also has an expanded PR room and observatory on the fifth floor. The observatory allows people to watch the planes as they taxi on the tarmac. The PR room uses VR technology to tour the airport, and explores the changes that the airport has experienced since its grand opening so far. Additional attractions include a photo exhibition on the theme of Palace Tour with Character, an exhibition of Korean relics and an observatory Osonsan.
