Mario Kart is one of the strongest Nintendo franchises with titles for almost every Nintendo console and handheld released in the last two decades and has sold over 100 million copies – but Nintendo sees a much larger potential audience by bringing mario Kart to phones. Drifting can give you double boosts, help you take speed, and really give that extra oomph to pull forward. Pay close attention to your tyres. When your character starts drifting, the kart wheels will send sparks; first blue and then yellow. The longer you last, the better your boost! If you enable Manual Drift, you will have access to a third (purple) boost. You can queue through courses when you have ultimate control over your drifting.
