Open the PDF at the DC Acrobat. Choose Organize the Pages of split. Choose how you want to split one file or more files. Name and save: Click Output Options to decide where to save, what to name, and how to split the file. Divide PDF: Click GOOD and then Split to finish. You can use additional PDF tools to extract pages or delete pages. Save as a new file: Name your new PDF file and click Save. That's it. If you want to save more than one file as a new PDF, you can choose multiple pages in the same Split tool mode. The range of pages will be placed in the order you choose them in the new file. Make sure you type 1, so it says: Split by number of pages. 1 Pages - this will ensure that each PAR is retained as a separate PDF document. The View menu is at the bar menu at the top of the screen. 3 Choose which pages to extract. Hold the Command key when you click on every page you want to retrieve. The pages that will be extracted in the new PDF will be highlighted. 4 Click on the file menu and select the print. The file menu is located near the top left corner of the screen.
