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The future of the indicative mood (Futuro Simple del Indicativo), also called Simple Future, is a verb that is tense in Spanish. We mainly use it to talk about future actions and events. In this lesson, we will learn how to conjugate and use verbs in Spanish Future Tense by providing sample sentences. We will also take a quick look at the Futuro Pximo, another grammar construction. At the end you will find a quiz and exercises to practice. Conjugation of verbs in Future Tense Regular Verbs that are regular in Future Tense is simple for two reasons: It doesn't matter if the infinitive of the verb ends in -AR, -ER, or -IR. The endings are the same for all types! We simply attach the endings to the end of the infinitive. The endings are shown in the following table: PersonEnding yo-é té-s él-é nosotros-emos vosotros-éis ellos-n For example, here are the complete conjugations of the verbs amar, ser and sentir in Future Tense: amarser sentir yo amaréseré sentiré t'amará'sser'ss sentiré élará'ser-sentir' nosotrosamaremosseremosssentiremos vosotrosamarésseréss sentiréis ellosamará'ser'h sentirén Irregular verbs but the trunk represents a certain irregularity. Here is a list of the main irregularities. Apart from the endings, everything is the same in these two times: they have the same irregular verbs with the same irregular stems. We invite you to compare them and observe how similar they are. Uses of Future Tense In general, we use the Future Tense to talk about events or actions that will happen in the future. However, it has some other uses. Here are its main applications: Future actions and events Examples: El a'o que viene iré a América.Next year I will go to America. Where will you be next week? El Director diré algo ma'ana. The director will say something tomorrow. En 2040 tendremos sesenta a'os. By 2040, we will be sixty years old. Predictions :Crees que el Real Madrid ganará la liga? Do you think Real Madrid will win the league? El aéo que viene conocerés al hombre de tus sueós. Next year you will meet the man of your dreams. Presiento que muy pronto ocurrirá algo increíble. I can feel that something amazing is going to happen very soon. Give commands in an epic or solemn tone For example, the commandments of Christianity are expressed in Future Tense in Spanish: No matars. You shall not kill. No Robars. You shall not steal. Conditional statements about the future (If A happens, then B will happen) The state is expressed in Present Tense, the sequence in Future Tense: Si encuentro un empleo, compraré una moto. When I get a job, I buy a motorcycle. lo pasaremos mejor. When you come, we have more fun. Si mis padres me pillan, se enfadarén mucho. When my parents catch me, they get very angry (enfadarse is a reflexive verb). To guess about current situations This is the strangest use of Future Tense: we can use it to hypothetically about the present, as shown in the following sentences: Laura no ha venido. Tendré algún problema. Laura didn't come. She may have a problem. Where could my pen be? Another future: The Futuro Pximo with Ir a + Infinitive In addition to the Future Tense, there is another grammar construction called Futuro Pximo that sounds good when talking about the near future. We form it by conjugating the verb ir in Present Tense, followed by the preposition a, and then the infinitive of the verb that expresses the action. For example, here das Verb play in Future Pximo: play voyoy to play t'vas to play élva to play we're going to play a jugar ellosvan a jugar And here are some examples in Futuro Pximo: El mes que viene voy a viajar a Colombia. Next month I will travel to Colombia. Ma'ana vamos a trabajar mucho. Tomorrow we will work a lot. When will you call Laura?
