At a time when most enterprise software vendors are bravely clinging to their sacred cash cows, bowing to all the mighty shareholder and ignoring some of the basic needs of customers, SAP recently demonstrated a refreshing mix of common sense, customer service and business minds. SAP has made a number of important statements that, taken together, show managerial thinking and decision-making based on reality, not just the blind adherence to the mantra that's how ERP has always been done. Let's see: Yesterday, April 29, SAP delivered the results of the first quarter of 2009. The number that everyone in the software and financial community clung to was SAP's 16 percent decline in revenue for the first quarter, year after year. However, software sales fell 33 percent, which in itself was alarming but not unexpected in this environment. During a telephone conversation with the financial community, SAP Co-CEO Leo Apofecker said: It is clear that in the current customers try to pinch every dollar, euro and yen before spending it. SAP execs blamed the decline on the restructuring charge related to previous layoffs. (For some fun, see THE SAP SAP bill close these slightly puzzled CNBC analysts trying to rain on his parade.) On the same day, SAP announced that it had changed the 2008 pricing program to support SAP enterprises by delaying the much-discussed increase in maintenance prices. (The maintenance fee was to go from 17 to 22 percent.) SAP and its global federation of 12 user groups have finally come to an agreement on key performance indicators (KPIs). These new KPIs are designed to accurately spell out what maintenance costs actually deliver, and how this is related to sap price increases. This event, in particular, was seen as a big win for non-cash and disappointed SAP customers. SAP execs, not surprisingly, trot out familiar marketing-friendly phrases: commitment to customers and a game-changing standard for transparency and a clear measure of value could be heard often yesterday. Two other recent events also suggest that things are not business as usual at SAP these days. Earlier this week, SAP and Teradata announced an expansion partnership to combine storage technologies and teradata database bi and SAP NetWeaver Business Warehouse software. Back in March, SAP and Sybase announced a partnership to get SAP ERP and CRM applications on all kinds of mobile devices. So what do these two deals show? Ready on the part of SAP not to try to build everything on its own, the goal that SAP used for the prize. Perhaps they have learned a lesson: do what you do best and partner for the rest. Of course, I was one of many who was very critical of SAP, Oracle and other software vendors enterprise business plans and outrageous maintenance fees. SAP CEO Henning Kagermann presented the first Business ByDesign demonstration in New York last September, modestly calling it the most important announcement I've made in my career. According to Kagermann, SAP Business ByDesign aims to offer a full range of ERP capabilities, from manufacturing to accounting and marketing and HR, in a service that is affordable and easy enough to use by businesses with 100-500 employees. Analysts say sap's challenge will be to offer a product that is easy for companies to customize but also meets their individual needs. Two of the main problems businesses have associated with hosted services, especially ERP, were data security and reliability of service, said Bo Lykkegaard, research manager at IDC (sister of the company's ICPS). But these problems are decreasing, he says, and the placement of services for CRM and HR will soon be basic. Incidentally, SAP will not offer customers a way to transition from its software to Business ByDesign, stating that the service is not intended to replace any other SAP solution.
