This time, the authors told about additional features that were implemented in the game, taking into account the feedback of fans. As previously reported, for Xenoblade Chronicles: Definitive Edition, composers have completely re-recorded the soundtrack, and players will be able to switch between old and new versions of music tracks at any time. At the same time, Nintendo specified that the authors went even further and added the opportunity, for example, to explore the world with an updated soundtrack, and to fight for the original, and vice versa.
