Kiyosaki is the founder of Rich Global LLC and Rich Dad Company, a private financial education company that provides personal finance and business education to people through books and videos. The company's main revenues come from The Rich Dad franchisees, which are run by independent individuals using the Kiyosaki brand for a fee. He is also the creator of the Cashflow board and software games for teaching adults and children business and financial concepts. Kiyosaki's seminars in the U.S. and Canada are held in collaboration with a company called Whitney Information Network and work with local companies as franchisees in other countries. However, some participants sued Kiyosaki over allegations that his costly seminars did not deliver anything special. Kiyosaki is the author of more than 26 books, including the rich Dad Poor Dad international series, which have been translated into 51 languages and have sold more than 41 million copies worldwide. He was criticized for promoting the practice of controversial legality, which was perceived as a get rich quick philosophy. Kiyosaki is the subject of class action lawsuits filed by people who attended his seminars and was the subject of two investigative documentaries by CBC Canada and WTAE USA. Kiyosaki's company, Rich Global LLC, filed for bankruptcy in 2012. Robert Toru Kiyosaki was born in 1947 in Hilo, then Hawaii. He was part of the Yonsei Generation of Japanese Americans, and was the eldest son of Ralph H. Kiyosaki (1919-1991), an academic educator, and Marjorie O. Kiyosaki (1921-1971), a registered nurse. Kiyosaki was followed by three of his siblings, sisters Amy and Beth and his brother John. Kiyosaki's education and military career was attended by Hilo High School and graduated in 1965. After that, much of the information about Kiyosaki comes from speeches and conversations he has made from his life. Per Kiyosaki received congressional nominations from Senator Daniel K. Inouie to the U.S. Naval Academy and the U.S. Merchant Navy Academy. He studied at the U.S. Merchant Navy Academy in New York and graduated in 1969 as a deck officer with a Bachelor of Science degree as a 2nd lieutenant in the U.S. Marine Corps. After graduating from college, Kiyosaki began working in the standard Oil tanker office as a third assistant. Kiyosaki resigned six months later to join the Marine Corps, where he was awarded the Air Medal during the Vietnam War in 1972. Per Kiyosaki enrolled in a two-year MBA program at the University of Hawaii at Hilo in 1973 while he was still in the army. In June 1974, he was honorably discharged from the Marine Corps. In 1974, Kiyosaki took part in Erhard EST seminars, which he said changed his life. In 1977, he founded a company called Rippers. The company brought to the market the first purses of nylon and velcro-surfer. Kiyosaki and his products were featured in Runner's World, Gentleman's quarterly, Success magazine, Newsweek, and Playboy. Eventually the company went bankrupt. Kiyosaki was a salesman for Xerox until June 1978. Kiyosaki then started a retail business that made T-shirts, hats, purses and bags for heavy metal rock bands. The company went bankrupt in 1980. In 1985, Kiyosaki co-founded the Excelerated Learning Institute, a company that teaches entrepreneurship, investment and social responsibility. Around the same time, he married his second wife, Kim, who had already invested in real estate in Phoenix. In 1994, Kiyosaki sold an educational company. In 1992, Kiyosaki published his first book, If you want to be rich and happy, don't go to school. In his book, he urged parents not to send their children to college, but instead to enter the real estate business. In 1997, Kiyosaki launched Cashflow Technologies, Inc., a business and financial education company that owns and operates the Rich Dad and Cashflow brands. Kiyosaki collaborated with Amway to promote his book. According to an interview with Forbes, Kiyosaki's main earnings come from the Rich Dad workshop franchisee. Other businesses and investments of Kiyosaki's two previous businesses (surf bags with Velcro fasteners and T-shirts) went bankrupt. In an interview with CBC, Kiyosaki described his books as advertising his more expensive seminars. In 2012, Kiyosaki's company, Rich Global LLC, filed for bankruptcy and was ordered to pay nearly \$24 million to Learning Annex and its founder. He manages other external businesses and investments. Business and Financial Advice Highlights: Rich Dad and Rich Dad Poor Dad Kiyosaki works through a number of companies that he owns entirely or partially, and through franchisee arrangements with other companies authorized to use his name for a fee. This includes Rich Papa Ltd., Whitney Information Network, Rich Dad Education and Rich Dad In addition to publishing several books on business and financial advice, Kiyosaki also wrote the foreword to Tom Wheelwright's 2012 book Tax-Free Wealth. Kiyosaki's financial and business teachings focus on what he calls financial education: generating passive income by focusing on business and investment opportunities such as real estate, business, equities and commodities, in order to be able to sustain themselves with such investments alone and thus achieve true financial independence. He has a number of authors and other experts who he often cites as Rich Dads advisers on real estate investment, financial planning, and tax avoidance. Kiyosaki uses the term assets for things that put money in his pocket. It claims that assets generate cash flow, such as dividends on shares, rental income, or business income. It defines liabilities as things that devour cash out of pocket, such as personal residence, consumer loans, car loans, credit card payments and student loans. Kiyosaki argues that financial leverage is crucial to becoming rich, despite the risks associated with using leverage to achieve financial independence. He stresses the importance of creating an asset first to finance its liabilities, not to save money or rely on wages from traditional work. Kiyosaki's personal life is married to Kim Kiyosaki. Kiyosakis has lived in Phoenix, Arizona since 1994. Kiyosaki's policies supported and supported Republican nominee Donald Trump in the 2016 presidential election. Criticism In 2007, the Ohio Department of Real Estate and Professional Licensing issued a statement warning people about some of the illegal practices Kiyosaki preached in his books and seminars. In 2010, the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation exposed fraudsters who had been perpetuated by Kiyosaki in Canada under the guise of seminars. Tracking the progress of the rich dad seminar organizers, they found that these allegations were not true. Investments in trailers and trailer parks, which were promoted by seminar teachers as successful, were in fact barren plots of land that no one used. From 1990 to 1995, Kiyosaki used Amway to promote his multi-level marketing book. In 2007, he was sued by his colleague Sharon Lechter for failing to comply with the terms of their agreement. Kiyosaki's council was criticized for emphasizing anecdotes and contained nothing in the way of specific advice on how readers should act or work. He replies that his material should be a tool to get readers to think about money rather than a guide to wealth, that rich dad was a fictional character, and that books should be interesting rather than include a lot of technical According to John Reed, a real estate adviser, Kiyosaki's books often advise practices such as illegal use of insider tips from wealthy friends (insider trading), as well as vulture real estate purchases and taking more credit card debt than can be processed and declaring bankruptcy when their plans go awry. In an interview with the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, he admitted that he had worked with a real estate firm to promote his business through his seminars. He also admitted that because Rich Dad's seminars were franchisees that functioned independently of him, he had little control over their content. Kiyosaki has been criticized for opposing education, advocating for people to drop out of school, and for deploying the idea that higher education is unnecessary for financial success. He ridiculed people with highly educated and academically successful and said that the best way to deal with class A students is to make them my employees. He described people who go to college as suckers and PhD holders, as people who are poor, helpless and desperate, alluding to Kiyosaki's own father, who became poor and unemployed in the last years of his life despite being a PhD candidate. In 2010, CBS News' Allan Roth documented what happened when he attended one of Rich Pope's free seminars and dissected some of the tactics used. Exposing the Marketplace at his seminars in Canada showed what happened at the \$450 seminars through a hidden camera, including Kiyosaki's response to them.
