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Acheen St. Mosque (officially Masjid Lebuh Aceh) is notable for its Egyptian-style minaret: since most local mosques have Moorish-style minarets, this one stands out. Built in 1808 by a wealthy Arab merchant who came from Aceh (Said Sheriff Tengku Saeed Hussain Aidid), locals call him Masjid Melai. Learn more... Cheong Fatt Tze Mansion, a boutique hotel that is one of Penang's most famous landmarks in the ornate Hakka-Teohu-style building. Located at 14 Leith Street, the structure was erected in the 1880s when Hakka merchant, Chong Fatt Tze commissioned its construction. Learn more... Clan piers are part of the Penang Heritage Trail. There used to be seven berths until one was destroyed by fire, and now six remain. Declared as one of the last bastions of old Chinese settlements on the island, this waterfront society is home to houses on stilts of various Chinese clans. Learn more... The Assumption Cathedral is the oldest church in Penang. The proudly preserved 160-year-old cathedral is a World Heritage Church and was founded in 1786 by Captain Francis Light. Located near the Penang State Museum and the Art Gallery on Farquhar Street, the two-spire church is the only pipe organ in Penang. It was the first More... Cheah Kongsí is the first of five great houses of the Penang Hokkien clan. Located in a block near Khoo Kongsí, it resembles the great temples and palaces commonly seen in China. The rich building is the only clan house in Penang that connects the Malay, traditional Chinese and European strait design. Learn more... Dr. Sun Yat Sen's Penang Base is an exhibition showing through diorama the work of Dr. Sun Yat Sen, a leading 20th-century Asian nationalist who led the Chinese Revolution in 1911. He attracted support from foreign Chinese and became China's first interim president. Widely regarded as the father of modern China, he was born More ... Hainanese Mariners' Lodge was set up in the days before World War II when 49 stray hainanese sailors pooled their resources to create a shared lodge and club they could stay in whenever they called in the port of Penang. Called Loon Gnee Hing, it eventually became an integral part of the Hainan community. Learn more... Han Jiang's ancestral temple is the only Theohyu-style temple in Georgetown. In 2006, it was awarded the Asia Pacific Heritage Prize for the Preservation of Cultural Heritage, and is administered by the Penang Theohu Association. The temple is dedicated to the Taoist God of the North, the deity of the patron Teohyu. Learn more... Captain Keing Mosque is a pung in Penang. Built in 1801 by the first Indian Muslim settlers of Penang (troops of the East India Company), The building is located at the junction of Lebuch Buckingham and Lebuch Pitt. It is the largest mosque in Georgetown and looks sublime at sunset. It was named after the captain Of Keling (More... Standing on the top of a hill in Air Itam, beside Hill, Kek Lock C is the largest Buddhist temple in Malaysia. The complex is divided into three zones, while the temple grounds include hill entrance, souvenir, food and drink stalls and turtle-free pond. In the middle part of the temple are temples, gardens, pagoda More... KOMTAR is located in downtown Georgetown, along north-south Jalan Penang and east to west of Jalan Magazine. The 65-storey high-rise shopping mall is one of Penang's most famous landmarks with an observation deck on the 58th floor overlooking the island and across the straits to the Penang mainland. Learn more... The Temple of Kuan Yin is the oldest temple in Penang. Built in 1728, it is set on Jalan Masjid By Captain Kelin (formerly known as Pitt Street) and was built by early immigrant settlers from China. Upon completion of construction, the temple was one of the most magnificent Chinese-style structures in northern Malaysia. Learn more... Millionaire's Row is a sea-view area where penang's elite is located. Located along Jalan Sultan Ahmad Shah (Northam Road) it was a quaint European enclave in the early days of Penang, with state straits-style bungalows best described as unabashed exhibits of wealth. Learn more... The Nattukotai Chettiar Temple is the largest Hindu temple in Penang and perhaps the most famous. Dedicated to Lord Thandayuthapani, it is located on Jalan Kebun Bunga and was built in 1854 by Penang in the Chettiar community (immigrants from Sivagangai and Pudukottai districts of Tamil Nadu, India). Learn more... A fascinating fusion of eastern and western influences, Penang is Malaysia's most touristic destination. The island manages to embrace modernity while maintaining its colonial traditions; thanks to well-preserved heritage buildings, the capital of Penang, Georgetown, was included in the World Cultural Heritage List. Learn more... The Penang Batik plant is one of the pioneers of Batik production on the island. Founded in 1973 by the crafted Batik Sdn Bhd, it is located in Teluk Bahang, a short walk from the Penang Botanical Gardens. The complex is divided into three sections: an art gallery, a boutique and a workshop. Surrounded by plenty of tropical greenery, more... Fort Cornwallis is the largest standing fort in Malaysia. Located near the Esplanade and Penang Clock Tower, the star-shaped bastion is one of the oldest structures in Penang. Named after the Marquis charles Cornwallis, only a set of ten-foot-tall exterior walls remain, with a closed park inside. Learn more... The Penang Islamic Museum hosts an exhibition on the role and contribution of Malay leaders to the rise and spread of Islam in Penang and Malaysia. Located on Armenian Street, the gallery also provides detailed information about key public figures on the 19th and the beginning century and their cultural influence on Penang. Learn more... Penang Jewish cemetery billed as both one Jewish cemetery in Malaysia. Spread through more than 38,000sqft, this cleft-shaped plot of land was established in 1805. Set by Jalan Zainal Abidin (formerly known as Yahudi Road) it was once green lightweight, but much of it is being cemented more. Penang Jewish Read more... Penang Peranakan Mansion is Penang's way of introducing people to historical Peranakan culture. Recreating Baba's typical 19th-century rich home, the elegantly restored museum is a testament to Baba Nyon's cultural renaissance and features more than 1,000 antiques and collectibles. Learn more... Penang Road is a version of Hollywood's Rodeo Drive and arguably the most important street in Penang. It runs from Lebuh Farquhar in the north, to Jalan Gurdwara in the south, near the Kompleks Tun Abdul Razak (KOMTAR) Tower, at the intersection of McAllister Road. A mixture of modern-rich and quirky heritage, it's more... The Penang Museum and Art Gallery are located at the intersection of Lebuh Farquhar and Lebuch Light streets in Georgetown. Founded in 1821, it houses national and state treasures that include Baba Nyong's porcelain collection, furniture, jewellery and costumes, as well as eight paintings by Captain Robert Smith. Walking the streets of Georgetown a little more exciting, in 2012, penang City Council hired a London-trained Lithuanian artist, Ernest Sakharievich, and instructed him to breathe new life into some atmospheric Chinese shops across the city. Trying to generate awareness of the rich history of the streets, the project was More... The Penang Wonderfood Museum offers visitors a kitsch, kooky and in-depth look at the city's unique food culture with a life-changing display of Malaysian dishes. Located in a 1940s colonial building in Georgetown, the museum is divided into three galleries called the Info Area, Wow zone and educational zone. All hyper-realistic models of handmade museum Read more... P. Ramlee House is the former home of the iconic Malaysian actor, director, singer, songwriter, composer and film producer Tan Sri Datuk Amara. Ramley. Now the museum, which celebrates its illustrious career in the Malay film and music industry, is set to Jalan. Ramley (formerly Counterhall Road). Learn more... The Protestant Cemetery is the oldest Christian cemetery in Penang. Not far from the East and East Is Northam Road Cemetery, which was established in the 18th century for British colonial administrators, merchants and missionaries who arrived after the establishment of Penang in 1786. Learn more... SIM Leisure Escape is a newly opened theme park in Penang. Developed primarily as a tourist attraction, this eco-friendly enterprise perfectly integrates with the natural surrounding it, and the park has gained popularly international audience of the leisure industry. The Sri Mariamman Temple is a Hindu temple located on The Lebukh and Lebu Chulya in the compact little India neighborhood of Georgetown, a vibrant community whose exterior has sari, incense shops and banana curry leaves. Built in 1833, the temple is dedicated to the Hindu god, Lord Subramaniam. Also known as Arulmigu Sri Mahamariamman Read more... St. George's Church is located next to the Penang State Museum and the Art Gallery. Built in 1817 by the East India Company using kerdem labor, it is the oldest Anglican church in southeast Asia and one of the oldest buildings in Penang. Architecture and design are mostly Greek and relatively unpretentious. Learn more... The memorial clock tower of queen Victoria is a testament to Penang's royal connections. Commissioned in 1897 by a local millionaire, Cheah Chen Eok, to mark the diamond jubilee of queen Victoria. It stands 60 feet tall, with each foot representing the year of the 60-year reign of the queen. Learn more...
