AFMAN 24-204 (I), AIR FORCE MANUAL: TRANSPORTATION - PREPARATION OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS FOR MILITARY AIR TRANSPORT (OCTOBER 12, 2004) TM 38-250; NAVSUP PU 505; MCO P4030.19I; DLAI 4145.3; DCMAD1,CH3.4 (HM24)

It provides guidelines and procedures for the preparation of hazardous materials for military aircraft to ensure that such materials are packaged, labelled, labelled and properly prepared for transport. This guidance includes the supply of nuclear materials, excluding nuclear weapons of large assemblies and nuclear com-ponents packaged and shipped to the Department of Energy's Defense Nuclear Agency (DOE-DNA) TP 45-51 and its supplements. It includes labelling requirements, instructions for transporting passengers with hazardous materials and instructions on notification of hazardous material on board the aircraft. It implements the Ministry of Defence (MN) Regulations 4500.9-R, the Defence Transport Regulation (Parts II and III) and the exceptions of the Ministry of Transport (DOT) 7573 and 9232 (DOT-E 7573 and DOT-E 9232) for commercial aircraft under contract with the Air Mobility Command (AMC).
