But then, about seven years ago, something attracted him to design and build a car that could be driven on water. Today it produces two models of water cars called Dutton Marine. The company he founded, Dutton Cars, has since closed. Its two amphibious models, Mariner and Commander, give it the entire street legal market for amphibious vehicles. The big house is gone. Now he lives alone in an apartment in Worthing, which is 100 years old, the city is known for its pier and being the host of the national bowling championship.
