Dutch Bond Altered Form of English Cross Bonds, which consists of alternative harvesting courses and In this brick-connected arrangement, each stretching course begins in a quoin quoin 3quarter bat. Each alternative stretching course has a header set next to a 3-quarter brick bat provided by the quoin. This link is ideal for building strong angles along the wall that are under excessive stress. Source 7. Common Bond/American Bond This link is very similar to the English Bond, but this one has the courses of the headers inserted into every five or six courses. The headlines of the courses are focused on the previous headline course. This link headline basically acts as a brick tie between the facade and the support. To achieve sufficient bias in the standard general connection, the queen is closer to inserted at both ends of the heading course. The general connection is usually used in the outer support are chosen to be built with bricks of varying thickness. Rat Trap Bond In this regard, the bricks are stacked on the edge or placed in an upright position instead of the usual horizontal position. This creates a cavity (empty space) inside the wall. This feature helps in maintaining increased thermal comfort and keeping the interiors cooler than outside, and vice versa. This type of wall consumes less material because of the inner cavity.
