I wanted to take a moment to pour one out of Star Wars: Force Arena, a MOBA-style game that was closed almost a year ago. It was easily the best mobile Star Wars game I've played, and it's a shame that it wasn't viable or for whatever reason the developers were closing the servers. I will also note that this list does not include any AR-experience or lightsaber simulators, because despite how cool they can be, they are novelties and not really games that you can have fun for any true period of time. I also briefly mention Star Wars: Card Trader, which is an app focused on collecting Star Wars cards, as some of us used to do as kids. It's less of a game than a team with gamified elements. There is a community dedicated to buying, selling, trading and so on. With all that aside, here are the best Star Wars games you can still play for Android! The most beef game LEGO Star Wars: The Complete Saga, which puts all six games released from the original and prequel trilogy in one app. There are 36 story mode levels to play through along with 120 playable characters to unlock. As a bonus, there are no in-app purchases because it is a paid app. There are also several free LEGO Star Wars games available: Lego Star Wars: The Force Awakens and LEGO Star Wars Microfighters. Both are free to play, but not as complete a collection as a paid collection of games. LEGO Star Wars games are fun to play and full of cheeky humor that is perfect for kids and older franchise fans. The complete Saga collection is of great value, and the games are compatible with Bluetooth controllers, too. Star Wars: Knights of the Old Republic (KOTOR) is one of those legendary games that fans still speak highly of so many years after its initial release. This is an epic RPG set in the Star Wars universe that you play a power-sensitive character feeling to pull both with the dark side and the light side of the force. Originally developed by BioWare and LucasArts, it has a history that takes place 4,000 years before the rise of the Galactic Empire, where Sith Lord Darth Malak unleashed an attack on the Republic and left the Jedi unorganized and scattered. This is a fresh story from the film trilogy, which, depending on the choices you make in history, you either fight for the lighter side to try to defeat Malak or going full on the Sith and try to try become the worst MoFo in the galaxy. Keep in mind that this game was originally released for Xbox and PC back in 2003, so the graphics don't age well, but the gameplay is still fantastic, even on Android. It is still considered one of the best games installed in the Star Wars universe. To this day, KOTOR is revered as one of the greatest Star Wars video games ever created. Although the graphics are not aged and over the years, a few other games give you the freedom to explore the Star Wars universe as KOTOR does. Galaxy of Heroes allows you to create squads of characters from different Star Wars movies and TV shows - both heroes and villains - including the likes of Luke Skywalker, Princess Leia, Darth Vader and Boba Fett. Each character has unique fighting abilities that can be updated over time and unleashed against your enemies. The game has a strategic, RPG-style fight, so you need to mix your squads to make the best use of each character's abilities. The game comes out in 2015 - shortly before the release of The Force Awakens - and since then, longtime players have discovered that there is a point at which the character's progression basically stops if you don't start spending on in-app purchases. This is disappointing because the game otherwise does a great job of delivering bite-sized Star Wars action that you can play on the go. Galaxy of Heroes is an action-packed RPG in turn, allowing you to build your dream team of Star Wars characters on both sides of the galactic conflict. At its core, Commander looks like just another Clash of Clan-style game, but he does such a good job at staying true to the source material that he manages to stand out from his similar competition. You can choose between supporting the Empire or joining the Rebellion, then you create your base and strike against the other side. There's a history mode to go through and you can also attack other rivals or team with friends as a squad and go to war with other squads. Overall, everything feels in line with what the Star Wars brand is all about. Authenticity continues even until the screen wipe transitions and voiceovers. Of course, the freemium model kicks in high gear with multiple game currencies to stash, and long build times that can be accelerated by spending premium gems. You also have to register regularly to protect your base and collect rewards. It's all par for the course for the genre, but also a big reason why I stay away from this kind of games. Having said that, if you're down for the entire conservation of the galaxy grind, Star Wars: Commander, will be your new obsession. Star Wars: Commander is a basic construction strategy game that is very authentic for Star Wars Choose to join an uprising or empire and build your army and base for battle to control the galaxy. While there's nothing that compares to real lights and the sounds of a proper pinball table, Star Wars Pinball 7 does a good job of recreating the action on your smartphone. Instead, we get this unlicensed flight simulator that's not bad, but might be better if Disney threw gobs of money for the concept. You can jump into the cockpit of X-Wing, A-Wing, or other rebel ships (including the Millennium Falcon, which is teased as an unlockable ship) and there are 30 attack missions to play before unlocking tougher levels. The framework for the amazing game is there, it just needs to be fleshed out more. It's still worth checking out if you crave a Star Wars space battle on your phone. While Android lacks a true and licensed X-Wing flight simulator, this game should scratch the itch. Jump into the X-Wing cockpit and fight back against the Galactic Empire.
