He was awarded the American Sociological Association's Distinguished Contribution to Teaching Award, an honorary doctorate from LaTrobe University in Australia and a lecture by Robin Williams of the Eastern Sociological Society. The most famous work, The McDonald Society (8th place) has been read by hundreds of thousands of students over two decades and translated into more than a dozen languages. Ritzer is also the editor of McDonaldization: The Reader, and the author of other critical sociology papers related to McDonald's thesis, including Adorable Disappointed World, Globalization of Nothing, The Expression of America: Criticism of the Global Credit Card Society, and the best-selling series Social Theory Textbooks and Globalization: The Core Text. He is the editor of the Encyclopedia of Social Theory (2 vols.), encyclopedia of sociology (11 vols.; 2nd edition of the upcoming), Encyclopedia of Globalization (5 vols.), and is the founding editor of the Journal of Consumer Culture. There were other cases between this and when the book was published to which the author's statement was actually applicable.
