

In addition, the Germans secured their second continental treble, becoming only the second European club to do so, and became the first team to qualify for any European competition with a 100% winning record. As winners, they have qualified to play against Sevilla, the winners of the 2019-20 UEFA Europa League, the 2020 UEFA Super Cup, and the right to the 2020 Club World Cup in qualifiers. Since they have already gualifiers was given to the team that was top of the 2019-20 Eredivisie, the 11th-ranked association according to next season's access list when it was suspended due to the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, Ajax. Due to the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, the tournament was suspended in mid-March 2020 and resumed in August. The quarter-finals were played as a one-match knockout ties at neutral venues in Lisbon, Portugal (Estedio da Luz and Estedio Jose Alvalade) behind closed doors from August 12 to 23. In accordance with his campaign introduction before, the video assistant referee system (VAR) was used from the playoff round and beyond. Liverpool were champions but they - along with the previous season's other finalists, Tottenham Hotspur - were eliminated in the round of 16, following defeats by Atletico Madrid and RB Leipzig respectively. The association team, distributed by a total of 79 teams from 54 of UEFA's 55 member associations, participated in the UEFA Champions League 2019/20 (the exception is Liechtenstein, which did not organize the domestic championship). Teh Ranking based on UEFA country odds was used to determine the number of participating teams for each association: The Association 1-4 each had four teams qualified. Associations are 5-6 each of the three qualifying teams. The associations 7-15 each had two teams qualify. Associations 16-55 (except Liechtenstein) each had one qualification team. The winners of the UEFA Europa League 2018/19 received an additional exit if they did not qualify for the UEFA Champions League 2019/20 through their domestic championships. However, both qualified through their domestic leagues, meaning that additional entries were not needed. In the Association's ranking for the UEFA Champions League 2019/20, there were allocated places in accordance with the UEFA country coefficients of 2018, which took into account their performance in European competitions from 2013 to 2014. In any case, when the place in the Champions League was vacated, the teams from the most rated associations in the previous rounds of the respective path were promoted accordingly. In the list of contenders by default, the champions of the Champions League title holders (Liverpool) qualified through their domestic league (as runners-up in the Premier League 2018-19), the following changes were made to the access list: the champions of Association 11 (Austria) advanced to the group stage instead of the play-off round. The champions of the Association 13 (Czech Republic) reached the play-off round instead of the third gualifying round. The champions of the Association of 15 (Greece) advanced to the third gualifying round instead of the second gualifying round. The champions of the associations 18 and 19 (Israel and Cyprus) advanced to the second gualifying round. In the default access list, the Europa League title holders gualified for the group stage. On June 17, 2020, UEFA announced a revised schedule of quarter-finals, semi-finals of the competition, which will be played in single matches. On March 15, UEFA announced the suspension of the competition, which means that the remaining return matches will be postponed indefinitely. A task force was convened to reschedule the remainder of the season. On 17 June, it was announced that the Champions League would return on 7 August and end on 23 August, with the remainder of the tournament taking place in Portugal, with the exception of four unplayed as a mini-tournament style with the remaining fixtures, which will be played as one-legged ties. All other ties of the contest were played behind closed doors due to the remaining presence of the COVID-19 pandemic in Europe. The draw mechanism for each round is this: in the draw of the 1/8 final The group winners are seeded and the eight runners-up in the group are not seeded. The seeded teams drew with the unseeded teams, and

the seeded teams played the second leg. Teams from the same group or one association cannot be turned against each other. In the draws of quarter-finals, there are no seedings, and teams from the same group or the same association can be drawn against each other. As the draw for the quarter-finals and semi-finals are held together until the guarter-finals, the identity of the guarter-finalists is not known at the time of the semi-final winner will be appointed by the home team for the final (for administrative purposes, as it is played in a neutral place). In the guarterfinals and semi-finals, teams from the same city will not play at home on the same day or on consecutive days due to logistics and crowd control.
