The 2019-20 UEFA Champions League play-off round is the first round of the 2019-20 UEFA Champions League, where the 16 teams that lost in the 2019-20 UEFA Europa League play-off round and the 16 teams that lost in the 2019-20 UEFA Europa Conference League play-off round are paired to play a two-legged tie. The winners of the play-off round advance to the group stage of the UEFA Champions League.

The play-off round is a two-legged tie, with the first leg taking place on Wednesday, August 7, 2019, and the second leg taking place on Thursday, August 8, 2019. The teams are seeded based on their UEFA club coefficients. The 65th season of the European Cup, the UEFA Champions League, is a football tournament held annually by the Union of European Football Associations (UEFA). It is the most prestigious club football tournament in Europe and one of the most watched in the world. The tournament was first held in 1955 and is currently organized by UEFA. The competition has a rich history, with many iconic moments and legendary players. The format has evolved over the years, but the goal remains the same: to crown the best club in Europe.

The 2019-20 season is no exception. It features 32 teams from across Europe competing for the coveted trophy. The knockout phase is a single-elimination tournament where the teams are paired to play a two-legged tie. The winners of each tie advance to the next round, while the losers are relegated to the UEFA Europa League. The final is the culmination of the tournament, where the two remaining teams compete for the UEFA Champions League trophy.

The 2019-20 season is expected to be a highly competitive one, with many of the top clubs in Europe participating. Real Madrid, Bayern Munich, and Manchester City are among the favorites to win the trophy. However, the tournament is always unpredictable, and anything can happen. The play-off round is a crucial stage of the competition, and the teams involved will be looking to secure a favorable result to advance to the group stage.

the seeded teams played the second leg. Teams from the same group or one association cannot be turned against each other. In the draws of quarter-finals and semi-finals, there are no seedings, and teams from the same group or the same association can be drawn against each other. As the draw for the quarter-finals and semi-finals are held together until the quarter-finals, the identity of the quarter-finalists is not known at the time of the semi-final draw. A draw is also held to determine which semi-final winner will be appointed by the home team for the final (for administrative purposes, as it is played in a neutral place). In the quarterfinals and semi-finals, teams from the same city will not play at home on the same day or on consecutive days due to logistics and crowd control. To avoid such a scheduling conflict, if two teams are drawn to play at home for one match, the order of the legs of the tie involving a team with a lower domestic ranking in the qualifying season varies from the original draw. On June 17, 2020, UEFA announced that due to the COVID-19 pandemic in Europe, the final stages of the competition would include a format change. The quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals will be played in a one-match format from 12 to 23 August 2020 at the Estadio da Luz Stadium and the Jose Alvalade Stadium in Lisbon, Portugal. The matches will be played behind closed doors, although spectators may be allowed to consider the situation and decisions of the national and local government. After the resumption of competitions in August 2020, no more than five substitutions will be allowed, and the sixth will be allowed in additional time. However, each team will be given only three opportunities to replace, with a fourth opportunity in extra time, with the exception of substitutions made at half-time, before the start of extra time and at half-time in extra time. This follows on from FIFA's proposal and the approval of itAB to reduce the impact of fixture congestion. Due to concerns about the COVID-19 pandemic in Europe, the second set of the return matches was postponed by UEFA to March 13, 2020. On 17 June 2020, UEFA announced that the second leg would be played on 7-8 August 2020, the venue of which will be decided between the hosts' stadium and the neutral stadium in Portugal (at the Dragao Stadium in Porto and the D. Afonso Henriques Stadium in Guimaraes). On July 9, 2020, UEFA announced that the remaining second matches would be held at the originally proposed venues. The first match of the Atalanta-Valencia match was retrospectively blamed by local civil and medical authorities for contributed to the extremely high concentration of coronavirus cases in Atalanta Bergamo's hometown. Several Valencia fans and players also had positive diagnoses after returning from the game. The winners were announced and presented during the draw for the UEFA Champions League 2020/21 group stage in Switzerland on 1 October 2020.
