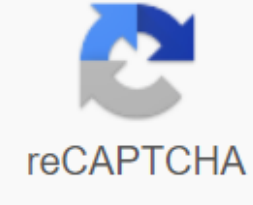

But since my Pro account expires in a few days (and I don't feel like updating it again), many of my old photos won't show up anymore. So I decided it would be a good idea to share the very best of them on my blog! These absolutely beautiful origami flowers were designed by Carmen Sprung and I just love them! Each flower is made of one sheet of paper, not from a square though, but from a pentagon. I would recommend using a fairly thick and strong paper (80-90 gm) to fold them - Tant origami paper would be just the right choice!
