The site contains technical information about movies and TV shows, as well as ratings, discussion boards and trivia. The database is popular because of its extensive nature, in that obscure, indie or cult films are also available to search and x keep records. You can refer to movies by their IMDB number, which, thanks to the widespread fame of IMDB, can also be used on other websites. Visit your IMDB homepage by typing www.imdb.com into your browser's web address bar. Find the search box at the top of the web page. Make sure the first drop-off field is selected at all. In the field to the left of the field, all will include the title of the movie for which you want to find the IMDB number. Click Go when you're done. The Chrome expansion brings in top information from IMDB, and sometimes Rotten Tomatoes and Metacritic, and offers information about the program's plot, and the main cast from the same sites. Unfortunately, this is an extension of Chrome, so its use means you'll need to watch on Netflix on Chrome rather than your TV. However, you can always use your computer to create the perfect watch list and then access it on your television later. How it works is pretty simple. Once installed, you see information about the show right under its listing on Netflix. The information is displayed in a pretty non-subversive map, so you can see it without having your experience dramatically converted. You can go to the expansion menu to customize what you see here. While all default to show an IMDB rating, you can also choose to get Tomatoes and and information when it is available, as well as details of the years the show ran on television and its plot. The extension will also link you directly to the show or movie discussion if you want to talk about it with others. Yes, like X-Men: Apocalypse feature the page and the personal page of Shipp, the actress is listed as playing Storm. A simple typo, you might say. Are you sure. Well done. Believable... for those who are not very well versed in the deception of the film industry. But I'm willing to assume that all this could be a misunderstanding... as long as you also hear my other theories. She plays Storm! Let Beginning by entertaining the idea that Shipp, in fact, taking on the role of Berry old as an obedient student of one Charles Xavier... considering this is, technically, the most realistic theory. A high profile character would be a big step for a young actress whose role up to this point skewed a little younger. Shipp's entry into the X-Men universe may be overshadowed by the simultaneous announcement of the casting of Sheridan and (especially) Turner, given the respect earned by the first and the fandom of Game of Thrones earned by the latter. said, we should not let Shipp lose sight. Fan favorite character Storm has been robbed of her because of the spotlight in the last few X-Men movies; perhaps some fresh blood recharges the franchise's interest in the development of the heroine. She plays a member of the revered Storm nobility from sci-fi writer Marion Zimmer Bradley's Darkover novel series Lights Less Feasible, but Listen to Me! Who says that the time-jumping X-Men series can't shoot their characters at the dawn of the 3000s, the time of space colonization and intergalactic warfare? Perhaps the indestructible Wolverine for one reason or another will throw itself through a huge space, eventually landing in the company of a member of the line Lord Storm. Well, it's more than a little less feasible... Moving on. She plays Eric/Erica Storne, a double-sex ally of Lex Luthor in DC Comics canon. Sure, it would be a nightmare to bust through all the legal hurdles that would keep the DC Comics character from entering Marvel Comics cinematic property owned by 20th Century Fox... and supposedly not worth the effort, given the diminutive noability of this particular superhero. But hey, they have to do something to beat Spider-Man/Avengers: Infinity Wars Union on the beat. She plays Rainer Storne, a distinguished computer scientist in the field of differential evolution.
