Here are some tips - don't wait too long because you don't want to shop when the mercury hits 90 or higher. By the time everyone tries to buy air conditioning and shelves even in large box stores can be assembled clean. The American Association of Home Appliance Manufacturers (AHAM) has some more tips for choosing an air conditioner that will do the job without preparing an electricity bill more than necessary. Step 1: Turn off the power so the fan can't cut off the fingers. Your power supply may have a switch inside or a block that you pull out to disable power. Step 2: Vacuum fins by attaching the brush. Be gentle not to bend the fins; they are not much tougher than foil. Step 3: Unscrew the fan grille, set the fan aside and wash off the fins. Dial down the water pressure so you don't damage the fins.
