

The update is currently rolling in Germany specifically for users who participated in the one UI 2.0 beta program, according to media reports. Samsung also said it pushed an update for both the Galaxy Note 10 and Galaxy Note 10 models. The latest software development comes a couple of weeks after the South Korean company released a stable update to Android 10 for the Galaxy S10 series. A stable update of Android 10 for Samsung Galaxy Note 10 and Galaxy Note 10 brings firmware version N97-FXXU1BSL7, as reported by SamMobile. The update also comes along with the December 2019 Android security patch. In addition, the new package is about 144MB in size. While Samsung has finally brought a stable update to Android 10 in its top-end smartphone series, the latest development is initially limited to German users who were part of one UI 2.0 beta program for the Galaxy Note 10 and Galaxy Note 10.
