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Tailor is a very useful skill in the WoW Classic. Not only are tailors craft fabric armor, but they can also create bags for players to hold extra items. This makes tailoring a great skill for making money too. Check out the rest of the guide to learn how to raise the sewing level from 1-300! Unlike most other crafting professions, there are no collecting skills associated with tailoring. Instead, you will use tissue found on humanoids throughout Azeroth. The better quality of the fabric falls from the higher level of humanoids. You can use our tissue growing guide to help collect materials for all levels. Tailor is quite useful not only because of the bags, but also because they can create a powerful fabric armor. Some of the best armor in the game are made through crafting, and without the maximum level of tailoring, you won't be able to learn the recipes! And who can forget the favorite runecloth bag, the best bag you will have until you get really lucky! Many people use tailoring because it does not require a collection of professions. That's true, but you still have to kill a bunch of humanoids to collect the cloth! The easiest way to align tailoring, starting with one of the major cities of your faction. For the Alliance, Stormwind is recommended for less travel later, while Undercity is more beneficial to Horde players. Here's where you can learn each stage of tailoring: The Apprentice (1-75) - You can find these trainers in major cities. For the Horde, which includes Ogrimmar, Podgorod, and Thunder Bluff. The alliance can look for Ironforge, Darnassus, or Stormwind. If you get lost, just ask the security guard! Traveller (75-150) - Once again, a major city if your best bet. Don't be afraid to ask the guards for directions! Expert (150-225) - Once you are on a minimum of 125 tailoring, you have the opportunity to learn expert tailoring. The Horde players will have to train with Joseph Gregorian in The Town, while alliances will have to look for Georgio Bolero in Stormwind. Craftsman (225-300) - For the final stage of tailoring preparation, both factions remain split. Alliance must head to Dustwallow Marsh to find Timothy Worthington, while Horde players can search for Daryl Stack in the Hillsbrad foothills. There are many dyes and threads you need to train sewing, but they are all easy to purchase by a tailoring vendor next to your trainer. They add up, but they don't have to cost a much-noticed amount. The fabric falls from humanoids anywhere in the world. Chances are you're going to need more than anything else. Perhaps the best place for a farm to runecloth is in Silithus. Use our guide to growing fabrics to help. When you leave to go train in artisan level tailoring, bring all the fabrics you need to reach 300! The last thing you want to do is that you need to buy more or visit the bank when you are already in the middle zone! Zone! About the amount of materials you need to align from 1-300 in tailoring. Some numbers may vary slightly depending on how lucky (or unlucky) you are on skill ups. For simplicity, bolts are not included in this amount because you will do them with the fabric listed here, but you can see the bolt totals under each alignment segment. Don't forget that you can buy threads and dyes on tailoring suppliers! Here's what you need: 160x linen fabric 180x wool fabric 760x silk fabric 500x Mageweave fabric 900x Runecloth 90x Rugged Leather 45x Rough thread 115x Thin thread 35x Silk thread 60x Heavy Silken Thread 40x Rune Thread 5x Grey Dye 30x Blue Dye 10x Bleacher 65x Red Dye Mats Required: 160x Linen Fabric 50x Bolt Linen Fabric 45x Rough Thread 5x Red Dye - will be created during this guide. Bolt linen fabric x80 (2x linen fabric) The very first recipe you will be making for a while. You want to make a total of 80 bolts, but you will stop getting levels after 50 sewing. Make sure you keep all of them as you will need them for future models! Heavy linen gloves x10 (2x Bolt linen fabric and 1x rough thread) For your first piece of armor, make 10 heavy linen gloves to bring you 60 sewing. Don't forget to buy a rough thread from the sewing supplier! Red linen shirt x5 (2x Bolt linen fabric - 1x Rough thread - 1x Red Dye) For the next few levels you will need to make some colorful shirts! Don't worry, because red dye red-dye-lee is available at a tailoring vendor near you! Enhanced by the linen cape x10 (2x Bolt linen fabric and 3x rough thread) With all the rough streams these capes use, you really start to wonder where it all goes! You'll need a total of 30 rough threads to make 10 reinforced capes. Don't forget to learn apprentice tailoring from the trainer! Mats Required: 180x Wool Fabric 55x Bolt Wool Fabric 40x Thin Thread 5x Grey Dye 760x Silk Fabric 10x Bolt Silk Fabric 10x Blue Dye - to be created during this guide. Bolt from Woolen Cloth x60 (3x Woolen Cloth) It's time to switch to a new fabric - wool! You want to make a total of 60 bolts, but you will stop your skills after sewing level 105. Grey Woolen Shirt x5 (2x Bolt from Woolen Cloth - 1x Thin Thread - 1x Grey Dye) For your next few levels, you're going to turn these wool bolts into some fancy shirts! Make a total of 5 grey wool shirts, so you have a high enough level to make the next pattern. Grey dye is also sold by tailoring suppliers. Double sewn woolen shoulders x15 (3x Bolt from Woolen Cloth and 2x Thin Thread) Next on the agenda are some Pads! You want to make a total of 15 of them. Consider selling these at auction as they are often sought after as one of the lowest level shoulders available. Bolt silk fabric x190 (4x silk fabric) You finally made it through all the itchy wool Now you can switch to something softer like silk! You will be making silk bolts for quite a while. Sit back and make a total of 190 for upcoming models. Azure Silk Hood x5 (2x Bolt Silk Fabric - 2x Blue Dye - 1x Fine Thread) These colorful blue bad boys are another popular piece of armor. They are one of the previous hoods available to wear (except for engineering glasses). You only need 5 to reach 150, but you'll make another 10 to reach 160. So feel free to make 15, but be sure to learn expert tailoring to raise your skill cap to 225! For Alliance players, this means training at Stormwind, while the Horde players must go to Undercity! Mats Required: 185x Bolt Silk Fabric 20x Blue Dye 75x Thin Thread 10x Bleacher 500x Mageweave Fabric 60x Red Dye 35x Silk Thread 20x Bolt Mageweave Fabric 10x Heavy Silk Thread - will be created during this guide. Azure Silk Hood x10 (2x Bolt Silk Fabric - 2x Blue Dye - 1x Fine Thread) Continuing where you left off, make another 10 azure silk hoods until you're in 160 tailoring, so you can make some headbands! Silk bandage x10 (3x Bolt Silk Fabric and 2x Thin Thread) Now you're going to switch your hat style to a headband! Make even 10 of them, so you reach 170 tailoring. Formal white shirt x5 (3x Bolt Silk Fabric - 2x Bleach - 1x Fine Thread) Be careful with this following recipe because it requires bleach! Don't worry, it won't actually hurt you, but you'll need to buy it from a tailoring vendor. Make 5 of these formal shirts hit 175 to unlock mageweave fabric recipes. Bolt Mageweave x100 (5x Mageweave fabric) Great job so far, you've now done it in the penultimate type of fabric! This is the last type you'll be using before using runecloth. You will need to make a total of 100 bolts, so you are ready for the armor recipes coming up. You won't use them for a bit, but make sure you hold on to them! Crimson Silk West x20 (4x Bolt Silk Fabric - 2x Red Dye - 2x Fine Thread) These bright red vests - all this rage among Azeroth fashionistas! This is good news for you because you need to make 20 of them. You will know that you are the right place when only 95 skill level to separate you from the limited! Crimson Silk Pantaloons x10 (4x Bolt Silk Fabric - 2x Red Dye - 2x Silken Thread) Woohoo, look at these pantaloons! It's not just pants, it's pantaloons! Now that you've the excitement has passed, make 10 of these pantaloons, so you're ready for the next template on this guide. Black Mageweave West / Leggings x5 (2x Bolt of Mageweave Fabric and 3x Thread) For the next 5 skill levels, you finally get the choice! You will use these mageweave bolts you saved from some time ago, but the vest and leggings have the same material costs. Because of this, you can really make any of them to reach 220 tailoring. For this step, you can also Orange Mageweave Shirt, which requires 1x Bolt Mageweave, 1x Orange Dye, and 1x Heavy Silken.Thread. Black Mageweave gloves x5 (2x Bolt of Mageweave fabric and 2x heavy silk thread) Now that you're 220 tailoring, you'll want to look for an artisan tailoring trainer suitable for your faction. For Alliance players, it's Timothy Worthington of Dustwallow Marsh. For the Horde players, head to the Hillsbrad foothills to find Daryl Stack. Make 5 black gloves magicians to reach 225, or make a total of 10 because you will make them up to 230. Mats Required: 70x Bolt from Mageweave Fabric 50x Heavy Silk Thread 900x Runecloth 150x Bolt Runecloth 40x Rune Thread 90x Rugged Leather - will be created during this guide. Black Mageweave gloves x5 (2x Bolt of Mageweave fabric and 2x heavy silk thread) Look familiar? Just make 5 more of them, so you're ready for the final mageweave template. Black Mageweave shoulders x20 (3x Bolt of Mageweave fabric and 2x heavy silky thread) This is the last time you'll deal with this dirty mageweave! Is it a joke, the magveivka is always clean, it must be magical! You will need to make at least 20 pieces of shoulder to hit 250 tailoring, a mark needed to start making recipes suck. Bolt Runecloth x180 (5x Runecloth) Great job doing it here so far! Take a deep breath because you still have a few ways. The good news is that you almost runecloth bags, the biggest bags that can be made! Make a total of 180 runecloth bolts, so you're ready to finish this journey away. Runecloth Belt x15 (3x Bolt Runecloth and 1x Rune Thread) Now that you've just done all these lovely run bolts, turn them into straps! 15 will do the trick, as long as you're on 275 tailoring. Runecloth Bag x5 (5x Bolt Runecloth and 2x Rugged Leather and 1x Rune Thread) yes, the real reason for the sewing level! 14 slot bags are the largest bags that can be manufactured. 16 slot bags can only be found through rare drops, so the market for 14 slot bags is huge! Unfortunately, they require strong skin. If you collect it yourself or buy it, use it to make 5 runecloth bags. This recipe can only be purchased from winterspring's supplier, Winterspring, or at auction (at a premium) if the seller is sold. Gloves Runecloth x20 (4x Bolt Runecloth - 4x Rugged Leather - 1x Rune Thread) You are now on the final sewing template that you will need to reach 300! These tight gloves also require durable skin. If you have enough for it, make a total of 20 runecloth gloves to reach the coveted 300 mark qualification level. Congratulations on your new level of 300 tailoring skills! Fun to make bags and robes! Here are all the vendors offering endgame tailoring Most of them come with a reputation for requirements, meaning that you need to farm that before you can even learn to create each recipe.
