One is connecting the device directly, so the operating system does everything itself, or search for drivers on the manufacturer's website and manually install it on the computer. 1. Installing a direct printer Depending on the version of your operating system, it can recognize the printer simply by connecting it to your computer. In the case of Windows 10, it is more likely to identify and install new printer drivers. You just need to do this: Connect the printer to your computer and turn it on; Windows recognizes the new device. In this case, set the drivers automatically; At the end of the process, the device will be configured and ready. Just like this, you don't have to do anything else. 2. Downloading drivers over the Internet If your printer is old, the chances of Windows 10 not finding drivers with the above method are great. So the best Download packages from the internet and install them manually, giving some extra steps. It is preferable to use this method for other reasons. In some cases, Windows 10 can only install major drivers without adding additional features. With old mats, for example, it can only include scanning and copying functions, but not paper printing. With official packages, you'll have the same set of programs as a CD installation. To install official packages, do the following: Identify the printer. Find a model and manufacturer in it to provide a search; Google search using terms: printer name, manufacturer, operating system, and word driver. For example, windows Epson CX4700 driver; The first results will be on the official website, directly on the model drivers page or on third-party websites if employees no longer exist; Go to the page and download the driver package; If the package is too old, you can scan it with an antivirus program (Windows Defender enough) before installing it. If you download it from a website other than the manufacturer, be sure to do so; Depending on the driver's age (in the above case, Windows XP time) you need to put it in compatibility mode. Click the right button and then properties; Click on the compatibility tab. Check the launch of this program in compatibility mode, and in the menu below, select Windows 7 (most compatible with outdated devices); Click OK and install the driver; Plug in and turn on the printer and set up. And that's it. Once this is done, the printer must be recognized and function normally. In recent weeks we have received a few email questions about how to install a printer in Windows. This issue is very common among those experienced users who have printers that do not have drivers for Windows 7. Previously, we published a video of How to install the HP Deskjet 1280 printer, but decided to create a general guide that shows all possible solutions for installing most printers. Is this a recent printer? We identified by a recent printer, a printer that has been running for less than 2 years. In most cases, simply plug the printer into your computer via a USB cable, and Windows will soon recognize the printer. If Windows can't install a printer, just follow one of two options: a) Visit the printer download page and look for a driver for Windows 7. b) You use the installation of a CD that comes with a printer. WARNING: If it's a multifunction printer, there may be some features (such as scanning, see the amount of ink in the cartridges, that will only work if you have installed software drivers. Driverless printer for Windows ?? There are two ways to install a printer that doesn't have drivers for Windows 7. Solutions: a) Use Windows Vista drivers. Since Windows 7 is based on Windows Vista, there are several drivers that are compatible with these two versions of Windows. Check it out and see if it works. b) If the solution doesn't work, you need to manually add a new printer through the control panel. This is what we show below, how to do it. How do I add a new printer? 1. Opens the start menu and presses devices and printers. 2. Click Add Printer. 3. Click Add a local printer. 4. Choose a USB001 port if you install a printer that uses a USB port. Otherwise, choose the LPT1 port. 5. Click the Windows Update button. 6. Choose to make and model the printer now. Then click Next. 7. Choose a name for the printer. 8. Choose whether to share a printer online. 9. The printer was successfully added. Click Finish. 10.
