It is customary to say, I propose to these three Mary's Degrees to increase the virtues of faith, hope, and mercy. Then say one Glory Be a prayer. Now you are on a medal that joins the beads. Here you will announce any prayerful intentions you have. Then declare the first Joyful, Bright, Sad, or Glorious Mystery, depending on what secrets you are meditating on that particular day. At this point you can read the meditation or look at a picture of the mystery that will help in your meditation. Then start the decade with one from our father all the time holding on to the medal. On ten little beads that follow to pray ten Hail Marys. Then one Glory be a prayer. Then Fatima Prayer. When you come to the big ball, declare a second secret, look at the meditative help, and then pray alone from our Father. On ten little beads pray another set of ten hail Marys followed by one Glory To Be and Fatima Prayer called a decade as before. Continue this model by declaring a secret and pray ten years. Do it for the third, fourth and fifth mysteries consistently followed by one Our Father, Ten Grad Marys, One Glory to Be and Fatima Prayer. After the fifth and last decade prayed, after Fatima's prayer, pray greeting the Holy queen of prayer. It is customary to end the rosary prayers with the prayer Let's pray from Breviaria, followed by the Prayer of St. Michael. Now that you've started, finish with the Cross sign. Main Rosary Guide - Mysteries Originally had 15 mysteries of the Rosary. Pope John Paul II added glowing mysteries or mysteries of light in 2002, making a complete Rosary a total of 20 mysteries. These 20 mysteries are divided into four categories, containing 5 mysteries each. The actual set of Rosary beads you may be familiar with like the Rosary chart above is only a quarter of the Rosary Prayer. It's just that it's how much the Rosary has usually prayed at one time. All 20 mysteries of the Rosary can be prayed for one sitting, but often you can pray only one set of secrets of the Rosary. In each set of Rosary Mysteries there are five decades of Rosary. You don't have to be a Catholic. The Order of the Rosary Prayer begins with the creed of the Apostles, followed by one Our Father, the Three Degrees of Mary (traditionally offered to increase faith, hope, and mercy for those who pray to the Rosary), Glory to Be, and, if desired, Fatima Prayer. Then there will be five mysteries, each of which consists of one Of Our Father, ten Degrees of Mary, Glory to Be and, if desired, the Prayers of Fatima. Make a hail at the Holy queen. Please pray for the holy queen after the Pope's hailstorm. Rosary beads if you don't have rosary beads, it's perfectly normal to take your fingers off. Counting beads frees your mind to help you meditate. Joyful Mysteries of Annuncia: Archangel Gabriel announces Mary that she will conceive the Son of God. Visit: Mary visits her cousin Elizabeth, who is pregnant with John the Baptist. Christmas: Jesus is born. Presentation: Mary and Joseph represent Jesus in the temple where they meet Simeon. Finding in the Temple: Having lost him, Mary and Joseph find the young Jesus by teaching the rabbis in the Temple. Glowing Mysteries More Epiphany in Jordan: The Voice of the Father Declares Jesus a Beloved Son. Wedding in Cana. Christ changes water for wine, his first public miracle. The Proclamation of the Kingdom. Jesus calls for conversion (wed. Mk 1:15) and forgives the sins of all who approach him. Transformation: The glory of God shines on the behalf of Christ. Institute of the Eucharist: Jesus offers the first Mass at the Last Supper with his apostles, creating a sacramental foundation for all Christian living. The Sad Mysteries of Agony in the Garden: Jesus sweats water and blood while praying the night before his passion. Scourging on the post: Pilate has Jesus whipped. Coronation with thorns: Roman soldiers crown jesus' head with spikes. Carrying the Cross: Jesus meets his mother and falls three times on the way to Calvary. Crucifixion: Jesus is nailed to the cross and dies before his mother and his apostle John. Glorious Mysteries of the Resurrection: Jesus Rises From the Dead. Ascension: Jesus leaves the Apostles and rises to heaven. Descent of the Holy Spirit: The Apostles receive the Holy Spirit in the tongues of fire in the upper room with Mary. Assumption: Mary is taken physically - presumed - to God's paradise at the end of her life here on earth. Coronation: Mary crowned queen and the Earth. Mysteries for some weekdays Traditionally, many people say, joyful mysteries on Monday, sad mysteries on Tuesday, glorious mysteries on Wednesday, and start again with joyful mysteries on Thursday, sad mysteries on Friday. Glorious secrets are then prayed on Saturday and Sunday. Now that Luminous Mysteries have recently been added, schedule: Monday - Joyful Tuesday - Sad Wednesday - Glorious Thursday - Good Friday - Sad Saturday - Joyful Sunday - Glorious Try to put yourself in a scene of a particular mystery as you pray, imagining the sights, smells, sounds and emotions that Jesus, Mary, Joseph, and other participants experienced during actual events. It is also normal to meditate on the meaning of the words of prayer as you pray them, or even meditate on the person for whom you offer the Rosary. Offering Intentions To virtually everyone who prays rosary offers the Rosary to God and Our Lady for intent. Some people offer specific intentions before each decade. You can ask God to give you a favor, heal a sick person, or convert a sinner. Some people offer the same intention every day - sometimes for years on end - especially when asking the Father to transform a particular person. Intentions are as diverse as people who pray. Ask for big and small gifts. Be brave! In this sense, the Rosary is the exchange of gifts between friends. It is widely known that Our Lady meets seemingly impossible intentions to those who first begin to pray the Rosary. It's her way of bringing you closer to her and Jesus. If you pray your first Rosary, or return to the Rosary after years of not speaking to Our Lady, ask for something big, exciting, impossible. She often surprises you. Deserving of plenary condensation, the Catholic Church, exercising its power to bind and lose in heaven and earth, and in full harmony with God's Mercy, set the following conditions for granting plenary condensation to those who pray to the Rosary: To be in a state of grace - that is, your soul is free from mortal sin. Be free from attachment to - that is, not out of habit - a venal sin. Go to confession a few days before or after the Rosary prayer. Receive Holy Communion on the day you pray to the Rosary. Pray for the Pope. By fulfilling these simple (but often difficult) conditions, you deserve the grace to free one soul from Purgatory. While we are free to ask God to apply this grace to a particular soul, God can do what he pleases, according to His Will and Mercy. You can also ask God to apply this special grace to your own soul. Plenary condensation will remove the temporary punishment because of sin (this will not remove sin and will not lead to forgiveness of sin). Full Rosary The Rosary consists of saying all decade, that is, all four sets of five mysteries. The Rosary consists of five decades of praying one set of mysteries. Many people pray full Rosary every day; or pray four separate Rosaries in the morning, at noon, afternoon and evening; or all twenty Mysteries at the same time (not necessarily repeating the preamble - the creed of the Apostles, etc. - between the four sets of Mysteries, if a man prays the full Rosary. The Rosary Family Rosary usually prayed aloud after dinner or before bedtime. Family members can take turns leading for decades, when one person prays for the beginning of prayer, and everyone else prays for the end. Some families announce their intentions before they begin the Rosary; others take turns announcing special intentions before they begin the Rosary; others take turns announcing special intentions before the beginning of each decade. Many families add favorite prayers at the end of the Rosary, or ask their beloved saints and angels to pray for them. Rosary Novenas Every time you pray any set of prayers nine times in a row, it is novena (novena is Latin for nine). There are many traditional Catholic novenas, and some are related to the Rosary. The most common is to say nine Saturdays in a row or for nine consecutive hours in the day. The most powerful Novena perhaps the most powerful novena is the 54 day Rosary Novena, which is a series of six consecutive nine days novenas. The first three novenas are offered for intent, while the last three are offered in gratitude to God in anticipation of giving favor.
