Bad news, gladiators - Olivia Pope hangs up her white hat. According to numerous reports, the scandal will end after its upcoming seventh season. The show is currently in the midst of airing Season 6 and has three episodes remaining, with its two-hour finale set for May 18. ABC declined to comment on the news, but TVLine first reported Wednesday that the network is expected to make an official announcement about the future fan-favorite show at its upfront presentation next week. TVLine also pointed out that showrunner Shonda Rhimes made the decision to end the series after Season 7, rather than ABC choosing to cancel it. While the ratings scandal isn't as high as Rhimes' stalwart Grey's Anatomy, it continues to consistently ranks among the top 20 broadcast shows in advertising prized by an adult 18-49 viewers demographic, and continues to dominate the conversation on social media during its timeslot. However, it hit series lows in the ratings in April, and is now averaging 5.7 million viewers - significantly down from its heyday in seasons 3 and 4, when he regularly pulled in about 12 million. He's been on the air for 17 seasons so far. Aside from detective stories being amazing characters and horrific cases, much of his success is that unfortunately real life gives him fresh stuff. Many episodes of procedural are based on the real headlines of horrific crimes. Some of them are perpetrated by ordinary people and against them. But there were episodes based on famous celebrities and their scandals, some of which killed their careers. So what high-profile cases inspired the episodes? These 11 are among the few that have been featured on the show. 1. 'Selfish' based on Casey Anthony Casey Anthony Anthony(en) Red Huber-Pool/Getty Images In Season 10, the show took the story that took the country by storm: Casey Anthony, a mother who was found not guilty of murdering her 2-year-old daughter in 2011. The mother was caught lying down several times, including saying that a nanny named zenida kidnapped her daughter. The show has Stabler and Benson getting a case about a missing little girl, and her mother Ashley Walker (played by Hilary Duff) is a suspect. In an episode of the crime show, Green and Cassidy investigate the death of a publishing agent who worked with a former athlete writing a book about how he would kill his wife if he did. 3. Pattern behavior is based on Kobe Bryant's Kobe Bryant/Getty Images In 2003, a married basketball player accused of raping a 19-year-old employee of the hotel where he was staying. He claimed that they had consensual sex and a year later the rape charges were dropped because the victim refused to testify. According to MSNBC, the situation was settled outside court. The show took on this story, also with a basketball player accused of raping but also killing his mistress. The player's wife stands next to him and even gives evidence in court. 4. Baby It's You is based on JonBenet Ramsey's Grave JonBenet Ramsey/Getty Images In 1996, a 6-year-old girl was killed and found with duct tape on her lips and a cord twisted around her neck at her family home. A ransom note demanding \$118,000 was left behind, and authorities confirmed she was sexually assaulted, according to PEOPLE. The little girl was also the winner of the local beauty contest Little Miss Christmas. Episode two of the series shows Munch and Curtis investigating the murder of a child model. The family however makes their work a little more difficult by leaking information to the press and offering rewards for information. 5. 'Crying Willow' is based on LonelyGirl15 Source: YouTube YouTube Channel YouTube shows teen Brie Avery talking to the camera about their days in high school. But then the channel went in a completely different direction, where Bree is kidnapped and then must go against an evil organization called the Order. Many viewers were duped into thinking they were watching the vlogger, but Bree was really the character played by Jessica Lee Rose, and the show was completely scripted. The crime show was inspired by this and made its own episode. Michelle Trachtenberg plays a popular vlogger who was actually kidnapped. Some believe that all this is a hoax, but detectives Logan and Wheeler are trying to find her. 6. Blood Brothers based on Arnold Schwarzenegger Arnold Schwarzenegger/Getty Images The world was shocked to learn that the actor and former governor had fathered a child with his former housekeeper Mildred Baen. As soon as the news started making headlines, the married man admitted that he was unfaithful and that Joseph was indeed his son. The show was inspired by this and made the episode loose based on the situation. The episode shows a 13-year-old girl pregnant, and try to find out whether the ambassador is the one who raped her. 7. She then went on a modelling and married a wealthy oil tycoon who later died. She then began acting in several comedies and reality shows. She also had to live through her son, dying of an overdose before dying of an overdose on prescription drugs. The show decided to take many liberties with both of their deaths. In the episode, a blonde stripper named Lorelei Meyler is the widow of an oil tycoon and has a drug addict son and a newborn baby. She and her son are murdered, and detectives need to find out who did it. 9. American Shame based on Ray Rice Ray Rice/Getty Images The footballer was caught on video punching his then-fiance (now wife) in the face, knocking her out in an elevator and then pulling her body out of it. He was charged with aggravated assault and agreed to counseling, USA Today reported. All the while his wife stayed by his side. He was released by the Ravens and suspended indefinitely by the NFL until he filed an appeal. In this episode, a basketball player named Shakir Shark Wilkins is accused of raping a woman. Many more women then come forward arguing the same thing. Benson and Carisi are trying to find out the truth. 10. Funny Valentine's Is based on Chris Brown's Chris Brown/Getty Images THE RBC singer attacked his girlfriend, Rihanna, in a sports car after leaving the pre-Grammy Awards party. Rihanna had extensive injuries from him reportedly punching, biting, and choking her. According to Billboard, he received five years of probation and six months of community service for his actions. In this episode, the up-and-coming singer also beat up her famous friend in the recording studio. IEDs take up the case, but she does not want to help the prosecution with his resignation. 11. The American Tragedy is based on Paula Dean and Trayvon Martin's Paula Dean (en) ABC Studios Show does switch things when it comes to plots based on real events. But it's one of the few that have mixed two real stories together. Trayvon Martin was a 17-year-old who was shot and killed by George Zimmerman in Florida. Florida. found not guilty of his murder. Paula Dean is a celebrity chef who has received a serious backlash because of her deposition of her admitting that she used the N-word and would make anti-Semitic jokes. The episode showed a Celebrity Southern chef filming and killing a teenage black boy that she thought was a serial rapist.
