Education and Experience In order to work as a training coach, a candidate must be licensed to teach on file in the state where he or she is applying for a job. Similarly, while some schools may hire individuals who have a bachelor's degree, a master's degree in related education is preferred. Applicants should also have classroom experience, usually five years or more, and experience mentoring other teachers. Those who have worked as directors or in other administrative positions may have more opportunities. The training coach's work environment works in a climate-controlled school facility and is rarely called for outdoor activities. The situation requires long periods of sitting or standing and periods of work in noisy, crowded environments. The coach may be called to travel around especially when attending seminars or seminars aimed at furthering his or her own education. While real physical labor is not necessary, mental stress is a common part of the job. The salary of a training coach's salary is about \$49,000 a year on average, and those who work in private schools and universities can earn upwards of \$70,000. Conversely, training coaches who work on small public school systems earn the least and can bring in just under \$30,000 a year. Finally, individuals who have a master's degree and several years' experience earn the most, and can have a salary that tops at \$80,000 a year.
