So you decided to go from iPhone to Android. Step 1. Open WhatsApp on your iPhone and swipe left in the chat you want to export. Step 2. Then you need to choose the more option and move on to export chat. Step 3. Once you're selecting, simply select the mail option and enter the email address associated with your address account. Step 4. Go to the mail on your Android phone and download all the WhatsApp chat files that have been sent via the iPhone. Step 2. Remove WhatsApp from your Android and reinstall it. Step 3. Now you get to restore the data screen where you have to choose the recovery option. Step 4. Then you wait for the recovery process to complete and choose the next one. Step 5. Voila! All your WhatsApp chats have now been restored on your Android device from your iPhone. WhatsApp users on Android finally have biometric authentication. Provided that your smartphone has a fingerprint sensor, you can finally use your fingerprint to keep your chats safe. iPhone users received a feature in February that allowed them to use TouchID and FaceID to open the app. Although the face unlock feature for the app has not yet reached Android, users can expect WhatsApp to make it available after all. Android users can choose to protect the app with their fingerprints. When enabled, the app will only be unlocked once users' fingerprints are authenticated. Even if users use their fingerprints to unlock the phone, the app will authenticate their fingerprints again when open. To enable fingerprint locking on Android: 1. Open settings in WhatsApp 2. Go to the Privacy menu in Account 3. Select the fingerprint lock option and turn it on. 4. Once you turn on the fingerprint lock, confirm your fingerprint. It can be either in 1 minute or even after 30 minutes. WhatsApp also allows users to use if they want to see text messages received in notifications when the app is blocked. You just made your first sticker. Click on the Add sticker button again to create another one. You will need at least three stickers to create a sticker pack. Here you are View all the stickers as well. Just click the Save button to add them to your account. Your sticker pack is now added to WhatsApp and is ready to use.
