The game was released as part of the PlayStation Portable Remaster series on PlayStation 3. The game introduces new regions, monsters and a revised Felyne combat system. Monster Hunter Portable 3rd is not an update for Monster Hunter Freedom Unite or Monster Hunter Tri. Monster Hunter Portable third is instead separate from the rest of the series, and much of the game has been completely revamped. However, he is also the successor to Monster Hunter Freedom Unite as the third game in the Portable series. Monster Hunter Portable 3rd HD ver. is a high-definition remastering game for PlayStation 3, and is the first of the Sony PSP Remasters series for the PS3. The game was released in Japan on August 25, 2011 and has improved HD graphics, 3D support and overall conservation support with PSP. Gameplay New Base Operations - Yukumo Village. This village has a feudal Japanese feel to it as from its design to its inhabitants. Underwater quests, however, have been completely removed, so maps such as Desert Island and Flooded Forest have been revised to get around this. Not all Monster Hunter Tri monsters are present in Monster Portable third - Lagiacrus, Gobul, and Ceadeus have been removed. zingore, the game's flagship monster, is shown on the cover. Guild Hall now has a hot spring similar to Felyne Kitchen from previous games that can be updated by cleaning special Hot Spring quests that upgrade the effects of the hot spring, as well as Felyne Whim Skills, which can now be selected and selected by the player. All classes of weapons from previous games (Big Sword, Long Sword, Sword and Shield, Double Blades, Hammer, Hunting Horn, Lance, Gunlance, Switch Axe, Light Bowgun, Heavy Bowgun and Onion) are present in the game. Four classes that were not present in the Tri (Double Blades, Hunting Horn, Gunlance and Onion) have been revised. Equipment for the creation and fortification systems has received various changes. Producer Riozo Tsujimoto said this area of the game will keep what was good from Monster Hunter Freedom Unite and Monster Hunter Tri and add new elements. The Famitsu reception gave the PSP version a score of two dozen, one nine, and one tenth, for a near-perfect score of 39 out of 40. Sales of the game were number one in the Japanese sales chart on December 5, 2010, replacing Gran Turismo 5. Within two weeks of its release by December 20, Monster Hunter Portable 3rd sold 2.58 million copies in Japan. According to the game's publisher, Monster Hunter Portable 3 is now the fastest-selling PSP name ever in Japan and the fastest-selling game in Capcom's history. Flooded forest: Underwater areas are still present, but they all seem to have dried up. The path from area 4 to 6 is no longer one route, and now there is a path between areas 3 and 8 (seems to be the one used by the monsters in MH Tri). There also seems to be three places (pillars) in area 8. Sandy Plains: The path from area 11 to area 7 is no longer one route. Tundra: The path from Area 3 to Area 5 is no longer one route.
