Did you know that Pokemon Revolution Online or PRO is being launched by a team of Fans of the Pokemon Universe?! What is the Pokemon phenomenon? If you consciously dived your mind into cutesy Pikachu and countless friends, made by Satoshi Tajiri for your Nintendo Game Boy in the late 90s. Messages labeled 'Pokemon sinnoh Java quest'. Pokemon Revolution Internet - PC, Mac, AndroidWebsite: [://pokemon-revolution-online.net/Greetings](http://pokemon-revolution-online.net/Greetings), fellow Pokemon wizards! I haven't seen a thread about this game in a while, so I figured I wanted to do a more updated one. If you've ever played Pokemon and how awesome it would be to see, fight and trade with other players in the game, keep reading below. Basic Mechanics: The game is played like any Pokemon game will be on a portable one. You start by getting Pokemon from Professor Oak to Pallet Town (Gen 1 Starter) and you continue your journey, catch Pokemon and conquer the gyms as you go. Currently, the game has a storyline that takes you through Kanta, Johto and Hoenn, with a slight twist: After defeating elite 4 of each region, you start all over again in the next region! Don't worry though, your Pokemon is stored and will be available after defeating the next region. More recently, the developers also announced that they have started the development of the Sinnoh region as well. Also, unlike some of their competitors, the level doesn't take so long and you won't find yourself grinding on wild Pokemon for 6 hours just to level up the beat gym. You will, however, notice that wild Pokemon are much stronger than portable games, and AI is harder to offset by the increase in Exp. The result is that you have to heal in the Pock Centers a little more often, but its not a big deal. The game also has bosses who tend to have hard NPCs with maximum Pokemon level. They have good rewards though, often rare Pokemon, and reset frequently (often once a week). Pokemon: Currently, PRO features Pokemon from the first 6 generations of the game and you'll find them scattered across all 3 regions, which is a pleasant surprise. At this post, there are about 570 catchable Pokemon. They all have movesets from Gen 5/Gen 6 as well. PRO does a very good job of displaying detailed information about each Pokemon as well. When you view one of your own or someone else's (associated in the chat), you can see all their stats, including IVs (internal values) for each statistic, as well as any accrued EVs (effort values) for each statistic. Other Pokemon MMORPGs in the past have either forced you to look at stats on third party websites, or not show you at all, so it's very handy. The game can get the kind of hardcore with all the min/maxing you can do with stats, but you can play as casual or as hardcore as you like. Many people just love hunting rare or filling them with Pokedex (and hunting shinies, too!). PVP: The PVP system in PRO is very polished and has a queue system. You queue up and get put in a matchmade battle. There's PVP ratings, ladders, tournaments and even currency (PvP coins) used to purchase unique rewards. Social/community: The community at PRO is one of the best I've ever been a part of. People seem friendly, helpful and always answering questions in the chat channels available in the game. Every place I go, I always see other players and the game chat is always lively. There are also guilds that you can create/join the unique Pokemon experience. Developers also do festivities. For example, last year's Christmas event featured some Pokemon, had a chance to be a different color when found in the wild (red/green for Christmas). There are also some great leadership guides their forums that helped me a ton. Step-by-step guides, caviar guides, TM/HM locations, etc. are all there. Membership/Coin Shop: The game is completely free to play, however, you can donate \$5 for 30 days worth of membership, giving you an increase in the Exp and PokeDollars earned. The membership token is also traded, so you can purchase it from other players with game currency. There's also a Coin Shop where you can buy mounts and accessories for your character. None of them gives you any advantages in the game, they are just cosmetic and help finance the development of the game. Negatives: I've seen other topics about Pokemon MMO and the main complaint I see is that Nintendo will eventually shut it down, so I'm not going to invest at any time in it. There are at least 3 other Pokemon MMO that have been running for a long time (Pokemon World Online, PokeMMO and Pokemon: Dawn of Darkness) and never shut down. I think there is a loophole in the system, saying that the game is made by volunteers and no one gets paid, can they somehow get around it? I'm not sure, but PRO has been for 2 years, so says something.
