How is the church growing? is a question of fundamental and ultimately eternal significance. Simply put, growth is achieved through the instrumentality of God's power of drawing the gospel (Jn. 6:44, 45; 12:31; 1:16), which is the seed that must be seeded in the heart and lifeblood of the church. Without evangelization, the church will not grow because the seed will not be sown. Only when the seed is seeded can it produce fruit (Lk. 8:15). Without evangelization, all those who are accountable to God, knowing right from the wrong, will remain and die in a lost state, never obeying the Gospel of Christ (2 He. 1:7-9). Because of the importance of the subject at hand, the question that could be considered is: Who should preach Christianity? It is often claimed that this is solely the work of a preacher, as Paul said said do the work of an evangelist (2 Tim. 4:5). Yes, gospel preachers are evangelist, but they cannot do it alone. The answer can be found in Christ's words in Mark's account of the great commission: Go E.E. (emphasis my-RA) into the world and preach the gospel to every being (Mark 16:15 KJV). When considering these words, it is clear that Christ spoke to the twelve at the time. However, this team is one of a constant character. There is never a moment from that this team treats you and me as Christians. I recognize that just as my name is implied in passages such as John 3:16 and Matthew 11:28, this is also implied in this particular passage of Scripture as well. When Christians. ALL have a responsibility to make their parts in evangelism. Unfortunately, many of them are Christians who do little about personal evangelism. Excuses abound as to why so many Christians don't engage in personal evangelism: They have no zeal for it (and in fact, the lack of zeal manifests a lack of interest in lost souls.) They are simply afraid (to be rejected, to forget what to say, etc.) however, all these excuses can be nullified, and all Christians can be encouraged by the fact that personal evangelism can be achieved by all. There are many effective methods by which you can participate in the work of evangelism that should encourage every Christian and thus instill a sense of zeal for this important work that does not take much time, easing the fear or fear you can have regarding the performance of personal work. The purpose of this article is to encourage each member to develop a mentality that I can contribute to evangelism and outline five effective methods that each member can or can use to spread the gospel. Social networks (Facebook, Twitter, etc.). Like everything else, social media can be abused. However, when used correctly it can be a great tool for teaching others. From personal experience as a preacher, he thrilled me to see members of the congregation use Facebook as an opportunity to invite others to visit with us. Is this evangelism? Yes! If you have the fear of talking one-on-one with a person, then this method is for you. Can you plan a rescue? it's so post it on the social media site, so those who are your friends but but can't be Christians will read what they must do to be saved. Social media can be used to have a good discussion of God's word or to answer questions that others may have in a less pressurized environment. Social media is a great tool that, when used correctly, can spread the truth about God's word in the far and wide simply from your computer. Good Biblical material (tracts, publications such as Carolina Messenger, etc.). The transmission of good biblical material written by faithful brothers in Christ is another effective way of spreading the gospel. Not only can you hand them over, but you can also leave such stuff in the hospital and doctor's office waiting rooms. When I preached in Cleveland, Alabama, we had an expensive sister who always took a handful of treatises or a house in the house/heart to heart publications with her whenever she went to the doctor or the hospital. Her method is to leave a bunch on the tables there for others to take and read. Was it effective? Yes, because of her zeal and effort she came to be known as the lady of the tract when she would appear in the hospital. Apart from the aforementioned offer, you might consider paying bills to place a small treatise in an envelope along with your payment method. Will a treatise be read? Perhaps not, but the fact is that by sending it, you contribute to the acceptance of the gospel into all worlds. A personal conversation. Christ is a perfect example of using personal conversation to address spiritual issues (please read and study John 4 and His conversation, with a Samaritan). Christ began by talking about something that both were interested in (physical water) that eventually led to a spiritual discussion. You can participate in a private conversation wherever you are (food store, work, gas station, etc.). Just with withe the conversation and you never know where it might lead. Remember that in evangelism, you should not come straight away to talk about the Bible. Start on a general basis, listen to the interests of others, take an interest in them and let the conversation go from there. It is personalization that makes the method of simple, personal conversation effective. A simple invitation to services. Have you ever thought that just take the time to invite someone to visit a congregation in which you identify with as a form of personal evangelism? Inviting someone is a form of personal evangelism because of your desire to have the prospect of a visit and hear the word of God proclaimed in terms of hearing the word of God proclaimed publicly. I know several people who have come to obey the gospel as a direct result of a simple invitation to service. Inviting others cannot as much for some, but as noted, it is a powerful method of personal evangelism. Spending time with those who Lost. We must spend time with them and demonstrate to them Christ as a place of care and compassion for their souls, because in doing so they will be influenced by our behavior to either obey the gospel or be restored back to their first love (p. 1 Pet. 3:1 ESV). Some dear brothers and sisters in Christ told me that they were converted to Christ simply out of the interest they showed by other Christians through their life in the gospel of Christ before them (p. Phil. 1:27; Matthew 5:13-16). A kind word, a good deed or simply your presence can have a great impact on others to come or return to Christ. Personal evangelism is not limited to preachers, it is essential that every Christian is active in some way, form or form. And everyone can do it, it just comes down to owning I can! Thinking (Wed. Phil. 4:13). As a Christian, let me urge you not to be intimidated by personal evangelism. There are many methods by which you can report good news about saving in other simple and easy ways that are not intimidated by personal evangelism. Perhaps one of these will work or works for you or perhaps you can think of something else that might work better, that is up to you.
