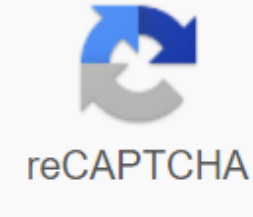

You may be familiar with labret piercing, which sits in the middle of the face just below the lower lip. Snake bite piercings are similar, but there are actually two separate piercings: one on each side of the face. Snake bite piercing is known for its striking appearance; it's hard to miss two big piercings right under the lower lip. The name piercing comes from the look it gives you: as if you have snake fangs, or as if a snake has bitten you right there! Snake bite piercing is a great idea for those who want to dramatically change their appearance, someone who wants a bigger punk vibe, or someone who just wants an attention-grabbing piercing. But before you head to the piercing studio, there's a fair amount to consider getting a snake piercing bite. There are actually two types of snake piercing bite: ring piercing and labret studs. These categories are exactly what they sound like: ring piercing snake bites pierced jewelry that completely wraps around the lip, while labret studs two piercings directly from the outside of the mouth inside. It's important to decide what kind of look you want in advance - the holes aren't pierced in the same way, and replacing jewelry styles can lead to complications with healing and irritation, says Gabriela Sosa, MD, advice-right dermatologist at Sadiq Dermatology. The piercing process is pretty straight forward - but remember; you have to do it twice! First, the outer skin is clean and marked to check for placement. Once you are sure the marks are exactly where you want your snake bite piercing to go, the skin is clamped or held taught, with your lip torn down and away from the rest of your mouth. The needle of the cannula is then pushed out of the outer lip inside, the clamps are removed, and the jewelry is placed in the hole. Then, you do it all again. I think... Something I can say for a certain: What hurts me can be how to poke at another person, says Marnie Stubbs of Bold Street Piercing. Pain can't be determined because of each person being different and having a different tolerance to pain. It is difficult to determine exactly how painful the piercing will be, as it depends on many factors such as piercings and tolerance to pain. If you have a decent tolerance for pain though, Stubbs says expect 3/10. Snake bites, like most piercings, have healing time, which depends on how well you take care of them. However, to be sure that your piercing is completely healed, it is best to give it at least 4 weeks, although it is recommended to wait up to 6 weeks. If you are worried about pain, Sosa recommends getting one piercing done while getting both immediately could potentially lead to more stress on your body and you could become more susceptible to something going wrong. Getting a piercing done one by one comes with your own obstacles though: you have to make sure that all the residual swelling is gone, or you could have an asymmetric piercing. Because of sufficient blood flow, oral piercings heal relatively quickly and without complications when all aspects are handled by experienced piercings and proper after care follows, says Sosa. When considering the cost of a snake bite piercing, remember that everything is multiplied by two. Thus, if your store charges separately for piercing services and jewelry, keep in mind you have to pay these two fees twice. And while the piercing price may sound like you can afford it, make sure you don't get the jewelry that's much higher than you can afford - or, double-check it's included in the price if it was a bargain. Stubbs says she charges about \$50 for piercings, including jewelry. However, she said the higher price of jewelry means a higher overall value. The cost for two piercings and two jewelry varies greatly depending on the region and jewelry choices, so unfortunately there is no basic answer to pricing, agrees Christy Tooher, piercing on the eternal devotion of tattoos. Some studios may charge separately for the procedure and jewelry, while others will have a fixed rate. As with any piercing, the best way to clean snake bites is to use sterile salt water to clean both piercings twice a day. It is also important to avoid harsh toothpaste and mouthwash or you may cause irritation on the inside of a fresh piercing. Staying hydrated can also help keep your piercing clean, notes Tooher. If these instructions are performed twice a day, then you'll be on your way to a happily healed piercing without complications, agrees Stubbs. There are four specific ways to make sure you take care of your new snake bite piercing in the best way possible with Soza. R-I-C-E: You may have heard of this mnemonic acronym for exercise-induced injuries, but the slightly modified version also refers to oral piercings - significantly improving the immediate effects of swelling and pain, and reducing the decrease in further complications down the line, says Sosa. R means rest, which warns you to try not to use your mouth as much as possible. Don't try, for example, to give a presentation the next day. If you don't allow piercing sites - and therefore your lower lip - rest, you run the risk of swelling, pain, and hard to understand. I'm for ice. A careful application of an ice pack or some other frozen, closed item gently on the outside lip can offer relief for the frontal piercing site. To also soothe the inner area, try sucking the ice cube. C for cleaner-like in: keep your mouth clean to keep your piercings clean. Gently brush your teeth after each meal and try to rinse with saline - or, as soon as it heals completely, mouthwash - to keep your mouth as clean as possible. Finally, e means height. Try sleeping with a few pillows tucked behind your head to help reduce swelling. An off-the-prescription non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug - like ibuprofen - can also be taken to help stop swelling and pain. In general, it is reasonable to realize what activity you are doing with the lower lip. Smoking, drinking, and even spicy food can cause complications for your new piercing. Swelling: It's common to have a bit of swelling around snake bite piercing sites. If it persists for more than a week after getting it recently pierced though, or if the tumor appears suddenly, you may want to consider seeking attention for either piercing (unless you're sure what happened) or a doctor (unless you're sure something's wrong). Infection: If you don't follow through with a proper postoperative, it's easy for your tattoo to get infected. Any sudden increase in pain, redness, or swelling after piercing should be alert - you may experience symptoms of infection. Don't expect the infection to be a big chunk of oozing plying; sometimes it's as simple as gentle, prolonged swelling. If something seems unusual, contact a piercing or medical professional. Scars: All body piercings leave a permanent mark, whether it's holding it or removing it. Before you get pierced, it is important to consider the risk of scarring if you decide to remove the snake piercing bite. Scars can also occur due to improper postoperative care and infections. The first step is to collect licensed piercings and ensure that sterilized tools are used, says Sosa When you first get a snake piercing bite, you can expect the jewelry to be more to make room for the initial swelling while it heals. However, after about 8 weeks, it is actually recommended to yo replace jewelry with something thinner. Make sure to go back to piercing to find out what jewelry will be best suited to, like what won't touch your teeth or other things in your mouth - leads to good oral hygiene and good for piercing. After the piercing site is fully healed - about 3 to 6 months - you can start changing the jewelry of yourself, says Sosa. To do this, hold onto the flat base located on the inside of the lip and twist the ball at the other end on the other side. However, it is imperative that you make sure that it is completely healed as trying to change the jewelry before doing so can lead to further healing delays and possibly lead to complications. Common sense is key; Make sure your hands, jewelry, and lips and mouth area are clean before gently replacing the jewelry - and don't force it, says Sosa. Any resistance or pain during the jewelry change should prompt a visit to your piercing. Labret Bar: The lab bar is a standard bar like the one used in the barbells; however, the bar has a flat base at one end and a removable ball at the other. The labret bar can be internally or externally threaded. There are many wonderful jewelry options available for these piercings, says Tooher. Your local reputable body piercing should have different implant-grade hypoallergenic pieces to choose from and they will also be able to help you get the right size and properly install new jewelry! Surgical Steel: You can expect to see most of the snake bite piercing jewelry made from surgical steel, as it is the most reliable due to its variety of appearance and overall quality. One thing to note, however, is that you can't choose this metal if you are allergic to nickel. Titanium: Medical titanium is the best idea for snake bites because it not only got all the properties of steel, but it also does not contain nickel. This means that if you are allergic to nickel, you can get the same customizable look without irritation (and bonus: It's lightweight!). Gold: Gold is a great metal selection for those who lean more towards bling non-silver jewelry. It is important to make sure, however, that the gold you choose for jewelry is at least 14 carats as nothing less than this could potentially be too soft and harbor bacteria.
