

Built in the 1964-1965 model years, the 356 was the first car manufactured by Porsche and the 356C was the first model to come standard with disc brakes. The 356C came with a normal 75HP engine or as a SC model with an upgraded 95HP engine. The 356C was available in both coupe and convertible body styles. Model designations by year were 356 (1948-1955), 356A (1955-1959), 356B (1959-1963) and 356C (1963-1965) with some C models still produced in 1966.
