Google Maps for BlackBerry is free, available in more than 20 countries and is really easy to install. It is compatible with any BlackBerry model with a color display, starting with the 7120 model and including the current BlackBerry Pearl, Curves and 8800 models. You will also need an internet data service from your mobile provider to have access to Google Maps and location information. You can download Google Maps in one of two ways: Advertising 1. Go to Google Maps and enter your mobile phone number. Google will send a link for download. 2. You can also www.google.com/gmm on your BlackBerry browser and follow installation instructions, which will be specific for your phone type. In fact, Google will do the test first to make sure that your BlackBerry model is compatible with Google Maps before trying to go ahead with the installation. Note that while Google Maps software is free, you can incur a fee for your data by using it to access maps. Your mobile service provider can provide more information about specific fees. Many companies offer an unlimited monthly data plan, and that may be the cheapest way to go if you get internet access frequently from your BlackBerry. You will be searching for locations or directions and see search results, maps and satellite images as they would appear on your BlackBerry screen. If your company offers Google Maps BlackBerry Enterprise Edition, you will be able to use all its features without downloading directly to your corporate BlackBerry device. Instead, your company's INFORMATION technology administrator will install the application remotely to your BlackBerry. When the enterprise option is updated several times a year, the administrator will send these upgrades directly to your BlackBerry. I'm going to let you in a little secret that might shock you. Not everywhere in the world has internet coverage. I know shocking isn't it? Sometimes when you are in the armpit outside, admiring sheep and cows, you look at your phone and realize with shock that your mobile phone provider's internet doesn't stretch that far. That's why when you're going on a journey, you have to be prepared just like the Boy Scouts. For example, if you need a map then you need to download it to your phone in advance when you are still in an Internet civilization. With Google Maps, the process is very simple. Here's how to do it on the iPhone, but the Android method is more or less the same. As far as I can see, you can't do it on your desktop. Download Google Maps for offline access after you log in to Google Maps, look for your destination. For this article, I just entered Berlin. Now click the hamburger icon on the left side. These slides open the menu. What you're looking for is Offline Maps. Click on this. This area gives you all the saved maps offline. To make a new one, click the Custom Card button. The square will now appear above the area you just searched for. Move the area around to get the area you want to download. But depending on how large the area may be, you may have to download more than one map. Google Maps will show you how much space you have on your phone and how much space the map will take when downloading. If you have the area you want, click the Download button at the bottom. Choose if you want to be notified when the download is finished. If you are on a hard schedule to get out of the door on your trip, you can turn this on. Now you'll see how the download starts. You can stop the process at any time by clicking the Delete button. You can also name your card by clicking on the pencil icon next to the header at the top. Assuming you have a decent internet connection, the map downloads pretty quickly. However, you have to keep the Maps app open to make it go as fast as possible. If you close the Maps app while it downloads the map, you'll see it. When the map finishes downloading, you'll now see it in the Offline Maps section. As you can see, the map doesn't stay forever. It expires in one year. But when you click on the card you just made, you will see an update button. So if you're going to the same destination every year, you can upgrade and reset the shelf life for another year. On the other hand, if you decide that you're not going there anymore, you can remove the card early Delete button. To use the map when you go offline, just open Google Maps and use it as usual. However, since you won't have the Internet at this point, the only part of the Maps app that will work will be the part you previously downloaded. The mobile app, which knows where everyone is - Google Maps, has now been updated to version 3.0.1, available for both professional and standard versions of Windows Mobile. Unfortunately, there are no new features added to the update, but this fix a few bugs and, more specifically, those related to Google Latitude. To begin with, Google Latitude now updates your location properly, while running in the background and after you've closed Google Maps. Keep in mind, however, that when Google Latitude is in the background of a location update, the feature will be able to receive data from cellular towers only, with no options for using Wi-Fi or GPS.
