Because these other app stores are not allowed in Google Play, you'll need to go directly to their websites to download them. Fortunately, this is a fairly simple process. But first you need to turn on the settings on your device, allowing you to sideload Android apps (the process of installing apps from places other than Google Play). Please note that turning on Setting up and installing apps that aren't affiliated with the Play Store can open up security risks to you. Make sure to download only from reliable places. We don't recommend this for first-time users; You'll probably find everything you need on Google Play. On Android 7 Nougat and older, head to the security and search for the Unknown Sources option. Given its priorities, the F-Droid has a much smaller library than competing app stores. Chances are, wildly popular apps from Google Play won't be available here. While polished, the F-Droid is visually quite simple compared to other app stores. However, it's easy and managing updates is not a problem. F-Droid won't store a list of your installed apps for access later, but this added privacy is part of its draw. How to remove apps on Android Once you've installed a bunch of apps, you'll eventually want to get rid of some. If you need to make room on your device or want to remove apps you no longer use, it's easy to delete apps.
