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Although all digital photos by Steve Heap are exposed to the camera in color, some images are more powerful if the photo is edited in Photoshop and given a general sepia sound. This redish-brown tone makes the underlying structure of the image dominant, and the prints take on an antique look. Sepia toning portraits and strong lines, such as demolished buildings or church paintings, are best for paintings. Open your picture in Photoshop using File, then Open. Select Image, Adjustments, and Unsaturated to remove the image. Add the sepia tone as a layer setting, which will enable you to change. Select Layer, New Adjustment Layer, and Photo Filter, and then click Complete. Select Sepia from the drop-down list in the Filter panel. Set the density slider to about 50 percent and Keep Brightness checked. Click All to apply the filter. Save the image by using Layer, then Display, and then select a different file name to keep the original image intact using the Save As option. Open your image. Convert to black and white using Picture, Mode, and Graying, and throw color information in the drop-down warning box? Click . Select Image, Mode, and Duotoneu. The Duotone Options window will open and allow you to select colors. Select duotone from the drop-down box named Type. In the text box that says # in the Color Selector panel, click the black square with Ink 1 and enter e38b2b. Click Ok to accept this color. Color1 vereb1.
