In the summer of 2019, House Beautiful editor Jo Saltz patted designer Jean Stoffer to remake the kitchen at her family's new home in New Jersey. Stoffer designed the space with a spread in mind: She doubled the floor plan by absorbing the second dining room. From the beginning, Saltz thought they might lose their natural light by removing a couple of sliding doors, but she says that installing a series of Pella Reserve windows in their place retained the airy glow they wanted. The kitchen windows, all from the reserve line, help illuminate different areas of space, and add to the overall design of the room. (They are also easily open and, as they are dressed in wood, can be painted in the same color as the walls.) When you enter the space, the first thing you really see is the windows, says Saltz. Whether you're looking for standard windows for new construction or renovation rather than replacement windows, and don't need many bells and whistles, ThermaStar may be a good fit for your project. ThermaStar line includes one hung, double hung, body, awning, and slider windows, as well as sliding patio doors. They also come in combined windows (which combine two standard sized windows into one unit), special sized/shaped windows, and bay or bow windows. Notable exceptions are the hinged patio doors, which are usually exclusive to high-quality food lines. You'll probably find a few basic types in standard sizes on the shelves in Lowe's, but non-standard sizes or windows with any special features, you may have to order them. Keep in mind that the availability of window types, sizes, and options varies depending on geographic location. ThermaStar windows, which are sold in the eastern territory of Pella, may not be available in their western territory. Any local retailer or dealer, ThermaStar, will be able to provide you with detailed information about what is available in your area. All ThermaStar windows have a double pan and argon gas between the glasses. Argon is an inert gas that helps reduce the transmission of heat through the window. Most thermal windows, i.e. double or triple, have argon or other inert gases between the glass because they resist transferring heat better than air. One additional energy efficiency update is the Low-E coating, which reduces the increase in heat, or the amount of heat that is allowed through the outside window. ThermaStar windows and patio doors are only white. It's not window replacement. Rather, they have a built-in nail fin on the outside, allowing you to nail the window directly to the home shell. This type of window is entered before siding is installed. Whether you are replacing siding at the same time as a window, or you are building a new home or addition, ThermaStar is a suitable type of window. If you just put out old windows and install new ones without changing siding or window finishes, you are in the window replacement market. They do not have fin nails and attach to the inner window frame. In addition to the presence or absence of fin nails (also called nail flank), the new construction and replacement of windows are the same. ThermaStar is usually a pretty cool offer from Pella. While the line includes basic modern features such as dual glazing, additional low-E coverage and insulating gas, consumers report problems such as problems with locking mechanisms and window belt sliding problems. Also, the overall fit and trim of thermaStar windows is not stellar. Corner welds are usually very noticeable, and the overall build quality is decent, but of course that's what you'd expect for a budget product. The main advantage of ThermaStar seems to be its availability (grab a window from Lowe and install it on the same day, rather than waiting 6 weeks for delivery); The possibility of a self-driving pick-up (saving delivery fees); and low prices. The energy efficiency of the ThermaStar line is pretty good in price. To compare energy performance, look at the U factor, the increase in solar heat, and visible transmission ratings. Ratings.
