In 1992, he founded the Isha Foundation near Coimbatore, which runs an ashram, hosts a yoga center and engages in various activities in the fields of spirituality, education and the environment. Vasudev is the author of several books, including *Internal Engineering: A Guide to Yoga to Joy* (2016). As a public speaker, he spoke at the United Nations Millennium Summit, the House of Lords of the British Parliament, the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and the International Institute for Management Development. He also spoke at the annual World Economic Forum in 2007, 2017 and 2020. In 2017, the Indian government awarded him Padma Vibhushan, India's second-largest civilian award, for his services to social services. Biography Early Life and Education Of Jaggi Vasudev was born on September 3, 1957 in Mysor, Karnataka, India, to a family speaking in Telugu. He was the youngest of four children , two boys and two girls. His mother was a housewife and his father an ophthalmologist in the Indian Railways. Because of the nature of his father's work, the family often moved. After studying at Demonstration Schools, Mysore and Mahajana Pre-University College, Vasudev graduated from Midor University with a bachelor's degree in English, despite a spotty track record and irreverent attitude to learning. Contrary to his parents' wishes, he gave up graduate school and instead went into business. Spiritually at the age of thirteen, Yasudev took yoga lessons from Malladhalli Raghavendra and continued to practice asanas and pranayama throughout his youth, albeit without spiritual aspirations. At the age of 25, on September 23, 1982, he climbed Chamundi Hill and sat on a rock where he had a spiritual experience. Six weeks after that, he left his business to his friend and traveled extensively, trying to get an idea of his mystical experience. After about a year of meditation and traveling, he decided to teach yoga to share his inner experiences. In 1983, he taught his first yoga class with seven participants Over time, he began conducting yoga classes in Karnataka and Hyderabad, traveling on his motorcycle, donating to the production of his poultry farm and donating collections received from his students to a local charity on the last day of classes. known by her nickname Vijji. After three years of operation, the temple was completed on 23 June 1999 and opened to the public on 23 November. The Dhyanyling Yoga Temple is a meditation space that is not dedicated to any particular faith or belief system and is open to all visitors, regardless of their religion or nationality. A stone pillar called Sarva Dharma limbha, located at the entrance to the temple, has symbols of several religions indicating the universality of this place. It was unveiled by Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi and has since been recognized as the largest bust sculpture of the Guinness Book of Records. He is part of the Unbelievable India campaign. Since then, the Government of Tamil Nadu has stated that all construction is illegal and no permit has been issued; The report by the Comptroller and auditor-general also stated that the construction had grossly violated the rules of biodiversity zones. Vasudev regularly holds meetings (mahasatangs) in the Indian states of Tamil Nadu and Karnataka. It also takes spiritual hopefuls for the annual pilgrimage (yatra) to Mount Kailash and Every year, Ish Vasudev celebrates the night of Mahasivaratri, an annual Hindu festival in honor of Shiva. It is estimated that up to 800,000 people took part in these celebrations in 2013. He also founded the Ling Bhairava Temple in Coimbatore, where women perform rituals. The Isha Vidhya Educational and Social Initiatives, an educational initiative, aims to improve education and literacy in rural India by providing quality English language education through a computer. There are seven isha-vidhya schools with about 3,000 students. The Foundation also runs the Action for Rural Rejuvenation programme in more than 4,200 villages, improving the well-being of the disadvantaged. Vasudev also advocated an airstrike on Balakot in 2019, the introduction of a comprehensive GST and the Citizenship (Amendment) Act 2019, denouncing Tutukudi's protests as a threat to industry. Vasudev accuses left-wing liberals of aiding and abetting militants in Kashmir and proposes to put Kanhaya Kumar and Umar Khalid, known for their involvement in the JNU insurgency, behind bars. His understanding of politics and history has been repeatedly questioned. Vasudov is also accused of promoting superstition and distorting science. He spreads the assertion, unsupported by science, that cooked food consumed during lunar eclipses depletes the prānics of the human body. It also perpetuates numerous myths about clinical depression and opposes a potential ban on the use of mercury in traditional Indian medicine, despite the extreme toxicity of the substance.
