

In 1992, he founded the Isha Foundation near Coimbatore, which runs an ashram, hosts a yoga center and engages in various activities in the fields of spirituality, education and the environment. Vasudev is the author of several books, including Internal Engineering: A Guide to Yoga to Joy (2016). As a public speaker, he spoke at the United Nations Millennium Summit, the House of Lords of the British Parliament, the Massachusetts Institute for Management Development. He also spoke at the annual World Economic Forum in 2007, 2017 and 2020. In 2017, the Indian government awarded him Padma Wibhushan, India's second-largest civilian award, for his services to social services.
