

REX/Shutterstock Fox Sports today unveiled its game plan and official television schedule for coverage of the 2018 World Cup this summer in Russia. Despite the lack of a U.S. team in the mix this year - neither world powers Italy and the Netherlands, for that matter - Fox said it would broadcast 38 games live on the network, more than the previous four World Cups combined and the most ever for an English-language network. In total, it will broadcast more than 350 hours of programming. The four-year-old football tournament opens on June 14 with host Russia vs Saudi Arabia and concludes on July 15 with the final - both in Moscow and at 11am EASTERN TIME on Fox. Fox Sports 1 has played another 26 matches, and all 64 games will be streamed live via Fox Sports Go and Fox Soccer Match Pass. Fox Sports won english-language rights to the 2018 and 2022 World Cups back in 2011 for \$400 million; ESPN aired the previous two tournaments in a 2005 deal for \$100 million. The 2018 World Cup in Russia is not only the biggest sporting event of the summer, but also the largest Fox Sports production in our 24-year history, said David Neal, executive producer of Fox Sports, the FIFA World Cup and VP Production. Our programming team has done an amazing job curating a schedule suitable for an event of this magnitude, showcasing exciting matches on Fox and FS1, including more matches than ever before on television. Early group games at the 2018 World Cup include Portugal-Spain in Group B (June 15, 2:00 ET on Fox), Argentina-Iceland in Group D (June 16, 9am ET, Fox), Germany-Mexico in Group F (June 17, 11am ET, FS1) and England-Belgium in Group G (June 28, 2pm ET, Fox). The playoffs will begin on June 30. Fox Sports will be a two-way complex based on Russia's Red Square with two sets, a main anchor table and an interview area for pre-match, post-match and late-night shows. Programs in the mix include World Cup Live, hosted by Kate Abdo; World Cup today, with Rob Stone; and the World Cup tonight, with host Fernando Fiore. Read more about: The Women's World Cup TV schedule for the summer of 2019 is over and the expectation is already building for the Women's World Cup 2023.FIFA Women's World Cup 2023 will be held in Australia and New York with English coverage of FOX and Spanish language broadcasts at Telemundo Deportes. This will be the first women's World Cup to be held in two countries and two confederations (AFC and OFC). The tournament debuts a new, extended format to show 32 teams that form eight groups of four. In 2019, Telemundo Deportes set a record for the most popular Women's World Cup in history, with a total audience of 301,000 viewers, a 27% increase over the entire 2015 tournament (237,000 viewers). In addition, Telemundo Deportes' coverage delivered four of the five most popular matches of the Women's World Cup in Spanish history - led by the U.S.-Netherlands final, which recorded a total audience coverage of 1.6 million viewers ranking as the most watched FIFA Women's World Cup match in Spanish-language history, surpassing by 22% the 2015 U.S. vs. Japan final (1.27 million).
