


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In review: The best book authors of this irreplaceable wallet originally installed 18 years ago to collect all the links notes that they made as new qualified physiotherapists for their clinical placements and rotation to create a compilation of key information covering the main areas of physiotherapy. As a result, we get a quick reference guide that can be stored in the tunic's pocket while in the wards. It has long been praised as should have for any student and especially aimed at those at major clinical placements - musculoskeletal disease, neurology, respiratory tract. A quick look at his Amazon ratings puts him at number four for physiotherapy, seven for occupational therapy, and Nine in counseling and therapy, proving the authors got their marketing spot on. This third edition - published just in time for the new school year - contains additional information on special tests and evaluation tools, an expanded list of general pathologies, an expanded section of pharmacology, more common acronyms and illustrations outlined in six simple reference sections: Neuromusculoskeletal Anatomy, Neuromusculoskeletal Assessments, Neurology; Respiratory tract, pathology and pharmacology. This will be useful for both students and clinicians when they need a quick reminder of key facts, and should be used in parallel with other literature and research. Each section is supplemented with links and further reading that have been updated to include the latest work. This is a book for readers designed to be quickly sliced before providing answers and information. Stand out features include illustrations, diagrams and tables that provide an instantly accessible reference source. On clinical accommodation, it is invaluable help to keep in your pocket and should reduce anxiety about notes left behind at home. The illustrations are clear and concise, while the grey, white and green color palette leaves plenty of room for notes so you can personalize your copy. The contents of the page are clearly laid out and I found color coding for the various sections useful as I thumbed through. The pocket option is designed for physiotherapy, occupational therapy and sports students. This will be useful for both students and doctors to quickly recall key facts. It is intended as an aid to learning and does not in itself provide a level of detail required by physiotherapists, and does not pretend to do so. The book is built under five headlines; Introduction, Upper Limb, Lower Limb, Trunk and Neck, and And the brain. Unlike its full-size namesake textbook, sections on the upper and lower limbs are designed to describe areas such as shoulder, elbow, etc. This is useful for combining all information related to bones, joints, ligaments, muscles and movements. A summary of the movements and muscles used will be useful for those who are starting anatomical and motion studies. The book contains many clear illustrations. Throughout the book there are examples of the application of anatomical knowledge in clinical settings, as well as notes on how to palpate structures - all this helps to emphasize the importance and relevance of theoretical knowledge in clinical practice.
