Just because the song Little Drummer Boy is loved by people all over the world, doesn't mean that its backstory is very well known to the public. In this review, learn about the origins of the holiday song, including the controversy surrounding its authorship and where its roots are. The lyrics and some story charts are also here. Before the song became world famous as Little Drummer Boy, the song was originally called Carol of the Drums because of the repetitive line pa rum pum pum pum that mimics the sound of the drum. It's not certain who wrote the song, but Little Drummer Boy is believed to have been written by Katherine K. Davis in 1941. The lyrics are said to be based on an old Czech carol. It was recorded for Dekchi as Carol Drum by the Trapp family singers in 1951 and credited to Davis. But Davis isn't the only person credited with writing the song. According to some reports, the lyrics were written by Henry Onorati and Harry Simeone. Just as it's not quite certain who deserves the lyrical songs credit to Little Drummer Boy, the issues surround the musical composition credits for the song as well. Jack Halloran recorded it in 1957. His daughter, Dawn, said in a letter to renowned music collector Jerry Osborne that her father made an original choral arrangement and recorded it for Dot Records in 1957. She added: 'The point unfortunately didn't put one on the 1957 Christmas season, and Simeone managed to get a drafting credit (along with Henry Onorati and Davies) for a piece he had nothing to do with. Over the years, it has been recorded by many artists, some of whom even charted with it on the Billboard singles chart. Pentatonix hit No 1 with it in the winter of 2013-2014, and David Bowie and Bing Crosby's favorite version peaked at No 3 in the United Kingdom (Official Singles Chart), spending 10 weeks on the chart in 1982-1983. Chorale Harry Simeone hit No. 13 on the Billboard Hot 100 with him in 1959-60, No. 24 in 1960-61, No. 22 in 1961-62, and No. 28 at 62-63. Jack Halloran Singers' version made it only to No 96 in January 1961. There have been hundreds of recorded versions of the song, and even actors Jack Black and Jason Siegel, believe it or not, reached No.45 with him in 2010 on Billboard's holiday digital sales schedule. Decades ago, stop-motion animation was all the rage on television (Rudolph, anyone?), so the version of Little Drummer Boy was produced by Rankin-Bass for television in 1968 with the voice of Eileen Evelyn Greer Carson narrating. If you're a certain age, you may have seen this version when it debuted. Although Little Drummer Boy is often remembered for lines that famously mimic the drum, a review of the lyrics of the song shows why it's really a Christmas carol. It's about the birth of Jesus Christ and the gifts given to the newborn king it's a big day. Broil 5 inches from the heat for 20 minutes, or until the meat is no longer pink and cooked through, turning once. To make the blue cheese drop, combine the sour cream, blue cheese and onion. Stir well. Then sprinkle with paprika. Cover and fridge for 20 minutes or until the flavors merge. Serve with chicken drums and celery sticks.
