Now fold the lower edges of the square into the central line. So it looks like a kite. Flip the kite base over, so the flaps are at the bottom. Then fold the flaps halfway to the central line. Sed the flaps to the central line. Then fold the figure point upwards. Then fold the swan's head down, fold the swan in half vertically. Then pull the swan's neck away from the body. As! Follow! What you need: 12 sheets of origami paper Now the first step is to make this type of origami to make the first block! 1. Start with one piece of origami paper with the color side face down and fold it in half. 2. Next, unwrap this. Then bring up the paper edge to the crease only you've done in step 1 and fold that down. 3. Turn the paper 180 degrees and repeat step 2 from the edge of the paper. 4. Turn that at 90 degrees, so you're looking at something like a closet. Open the left side door of the study and fold the bottom right corner to fold open on the left side. 5. Undo the right triangle you made in step 4 and close the left side of the closet. 6. Then turn it 180 degrees and open the new left side. Then repeat the fourth step, folding the bottom corner of the right hand until the left door folds into the closet. 7. Now instead of undoing this fold like you did before, you want to just close the left closet door with the right triangle still folded inside it. 8. Now this is probably one of the hardest steps in making this type of origami so carry with me :) Start by lifting the top right hand corner of the door as far as it will go without lifting the creases. Then take the entire top left corner and place it under the top right flap. You want to keep pushing it until it forms a triangle, just like one perpendicular to it. 9. Now take the entire shape to flip it upside down and proceed to fold the white corners down over the shape to form a parallelogram without any white showing on either side. 10. Fold 2 shape points to form a square. 11. Finally, you just want to fold the square diagonally in half, along the gap between the two points you folded in step 10. You can fold them in any direction. It wasn't hard now, was it? Now all you have make it go to do 11 more of these :D Now that you have 12 completed units, it's time to put them together. You're almost done! Note that there are dots (two triangles that hang from the square in the center) and there are pockets (4 small slots on the other side of the square). As you probably guessed, you're going to put a point in your pockets. But the important thing before you start is not to use two pockets that will cover the point of this shape if a unit has been inserted into one of them. Try to experiment to make a shape. It's a bit of a puzzle. If you are stuck try to make 4 pyramids by putting 3 units together to form a 3 one-sided pyramid-esk shape and then put them together. Experiment! The origami unit is wide open for experimentation. The shapes that you can create just knowing that the main unit is endless, the sky is the limit! The origami heart cards are simple in making and a great exercise in origami folding. Also, the message can be slipped in the back to show how much you care! 1. Place 6 x 6 square origami paper colored sides down. Fold the paper in half diagonally, bringing the top corner to the bottom. Unfold. Fold in half again, leaving the right angle to the left. Unfold. 2. Fold the top of the paper to satisfy the central crease. 3. Fold the bottom point up to meet the top crease. 4. Fold the right side up diagonally to align with the center. 5. Repeat on the left side to meet the central crease. 6. Turn over the folded paper; times sides and top points in 1/2. 7. Flip and insert a piece of paper with a message into the pocket of the heart. The technique is officially Kirigami, which involves one incision during the process. Kirigami is described as a variation of origami, which involves cutting paper with scissors to achieve the result. However, if you are looking for Kirigami online, you can instead find many pop-up cards and other complex paper creations. In traditional origami there are several known models where cutting is an integral part of the manufacture of origami. If you're looking for a few more origami animals to make, check out the origami jumping frog, the traditional origami world of pigeon, and the easy origami fox. 1 square sheet of paper of any size (minimum 5 inches by 5 inches for convenience) If your paper is the same color on both sides, it doesn't matter which side you start the folds on. If your paper has a white side, start with this side up. Fold the paper in half diagonally, so you have triangular shape, as shown in the display. Fold the bottom right corner to the middle point. Do the same on the left side. Chrissy Pk folded the top of the right flap down to the bottom. Fold the top left flap down as well. Fold about one-third of the bottom right flap to to on the left side. Chrissy Pk with scissors, cut the top front layer, which was not folded. Cut out the bottom point in the center. Now you should be able to move layers of flaps, as shown in the shown. Fold the top layer of the bottom flaps to match those you've already folded by following the mini step number 3 above. Fold the left and right dots inside, not all the way to the middle. You may have to use a little glue to make these flaps stay in place. Chrissy Pk folded the top points that you cut out. To form a head, fold these flaps back up, leaving a small gap. (It's called a crease.) Turn the turtle to even more form the body. For example, fold it in half for a more three-dimensional look and add a marker to your eyes for a funny touch. If you make a turtle, fold the dots for a more rounded shell, legs and head. Chrissy Pk To fold a traditional origami faucet, you'll need a square sheet of origami paper. If you don't have much origami experience, start with the big papers. Smaller sheets are difficult to work because of the parts needed when folding the steps of the crane. Origami cranes look pretty folded of patterned paper, but you may find it easier to practice folding a model with light hard paper first. Sometimes, it can be difficult to see folds when folding dark or busy patterned papers. The crane in this tutorial is made using 8 1/2-inch x 11-inch paper cut into 8 1/2 inches x 8 1/2 inch area. Spruce/Chrissy Pk is a pretty origami fish cute decoration and a fun way to push your origami skills. This traditional origami model is simple and takes just a couple of minutes to make. Since it's not too hard, it's great for kids to do. This traditional origami fish starts with the base of the origami windmill (which is shown). Once you master traditional fish, there are many ways to decorate them. You can create a whole school of fish in different colors. Another creative idea is to make Shikishi origami, which is a themed display. For this Shikishi, you can make a water display. Use blue paper, put the fish in the water, add a turtle, maybe a sailboat on top, perhaps a swan origami, and make a pretty scene to display in your home. This origami chart should be useful to work with to make your fish. By following the origami charts, it's helpful to look at the step you need to take next, as well as the next one to see what it should look like. Don't worry if you don't succeed in the first place. Origami is practicing. For this fish, you will need one sheet of square origami paper. Best to start with the usual origami paper 15 x 15 cm. el/Chrissy Pk 1. Fold the paper in half in both And unwrap. 2. Fold the left and right edges to the middle. 3. Fold the upper and lower edges to the center. 4. Turn the top and bottom flaps. 5. Pull left left right flaps from the middle up and side. 6. Crush the bottom edge to the center. 7. Now repeat steps 5 and 6 at the top. 8. Fold the top left and bottom points, as shown in the video. Spruce / Chrissy Pk 9. Fold the corner with the green dot to the red dot. 10. Fold the flap down from the center, as shown. 11. Fold the corner with the green dot to the red dot. 12. Fold the flap down from the center, as shown. 13. Fold the top and corners to the right, as shown in the video. 14. Here's what it's supposed to look like. 15. Turn the model to the other side. Spruce / Chrissy Pk 16. Now you can tap the area of your mouth in a bit and draw the eyes. For playful fish, feel free to add to your eyelashes. If you want, you can draw your mouth as well. You can make a smiling mouth, wrinkled lips, or anything else to give your fish personality. Remember that origami can take practice. Make another one and it will be better than the first one!
