It is a non-SI device accepted for use with International Systems of Units (SI). The problem is that you first need to know what kind of liquid ounce you are using. If you are a U.S. citizen, then you are probably using the U.S. usual liquid ounce (US fl oz). If you are in the United States or put in milliliters equivalent in a food or nutrition label, there is another ml equivalent. If you use UK or imperial liquid ounce (UK fl oz), you again have a slightly different ml equivalent. What is a Milliliter? This one is simpler. When you know how much liquid is in a liter, you only need to divide it by the conversion factor, which is equal to 1,000. This results in 1 milliliter. That's what milli- means-1/1000. How do you get the same results using your own calculator? It's really easy. All you have to do is first determine what type of liquid ounce (fl oz) measurement you have. Each type of liquid ounce (fl oz) has its own equivalent of ml. So you only need multiplied by the ml equivalent. Thus, you start by entering the amount of liquid ounce you have. Here we assume that you have 2 ounces, so we can use it as an example. But the same formulas apply regardless of the number of liquid ounces you have. 2 US FL OZ to ML Most of the time if you are an American, you use standard or usual American liquid ounce (fl oz). This means that 1 liquid ounce (fl oz) is exactly 29.5735295625 milliliters (ml). So multiply 2 by 29.5735295625 and you get 59.15 ml rounded. 2 US FL OZ for ML for Food (Nutrition) Labeling Rule for U.S. liquid ounce (US fl oz), however, changes when you put corresponding ml on a food label.
