

Basically, if a user or app encourages a device to do something like a picture, then the operating system will look for an app that can get the job done. If there are several options and the default option has not been selected if a new feature has been installed since the last default set, Android will ask the user which app they would prefer to use. This simplifies the process of setting up your default apps. So how does it work? First, start you want to assign the app by default.
