It is used to express the continuous actions taking place in the future at a certain time. The future continuous used for activities continues from one time to another. For example: I'll eat dinner from six o'clock until 6:30. Note: I'm talking about the situation now and I'm thinking about the activity that happens during that time range. Future continuous tense structure: Positive suggestions: Sub - will'be - verb-ing, which I will play tomorrow. We'll play tomorrow. You're going to play tomorrow. He's going to play tomorrow. She'll play tomorrow. They'll be playing tomorrow. A quick example: I'll play tomorrow. We'll play tomorrow. You're going to play tomorrow. He's going to play tomorrow.
