Many teachers in the United States believe that students should learn to analyze the text (understand it) even before they can read it themselves, and understanding the instructions usually begins in a pre-kindergarten or kindergarten. But other American educators find this approach to reading completely backward for very young children, arguing that children must learn to decode words in history using acoustics before they can analyze the story itself. The reason why understanding reading is such an effective learning tool is that, like art, it teaches students to manipulate particulars in an attempt to present the universal. When a student reads a text, he or she is forced to absorb many specific facts concerning the infinity of seemingly random objects (volcanoes, molecules, skateboarding, etc.) and assimilate them into the bigger picture, establishing how they fit into, or relate, to the wider world.
