A joint investigation by Forbes and Point Report has revealed some troubling features in the simplicity of the app for accessing child predators. While any messaging app presents horrific alarms to parents, Kik raises unique concerns for two main reasons: the prevalence of the app in the teen demographic, and its laissez-faire approach to privacy and security. Of The 15 million active monthly users of Kik, 57% are aged 13-24. What is particularly troubling though is that there seems to be not much regulation on behalf of the app, despite an increase in investment of \$120 million since 2009.The report cites open access chat groups where explicit photos and child abuse material are freely distributed between predators. The investigation also created bogus accounts as girls of a 13-14-year-old girl who during an hour of creation caused sexually suggestive messages (direct messages can be sent to any Kik user in the same public chat or known username, which can be amplified via a messenger through third-party applications). So what if your teen uses Kik, or any other messenger or chat app, for that matter? They didn't say anything sexually explicit in our chat rooms, but the tonal differences and innuendo were obvious to me even at this age, and I quickly realized that the conversation wasn't completely innocent. My mom remembers talking through the potential dangers of my new pen buddy, it was hard because you felt uncomfortable that someone might fool you like this. But we made our level of concern clear until we knew you realized that it's not a smart thing to continue with. We didn't read over your shoulder every time you logged in, but we followed for a long time after that to make sure you weren't in contact with that person anymore, or with anyone else that seemed suspicious, Mom recalls.
