You can buy certain drugs without embarrassment, and you can do it all from the comfort of your chair. But how can you be sure online pharmacies are legal? One sure sign if the site has a VIPPS endorsement. This certification is from the National Association of Pharmacy Councils (VIPPS means verified online pharmacy practice sites), and the print must be shown prominently on the business website. You can also check the NABP website for a list of pharmacies that have earned THE VIPPS print (nabp.net). You should be suspicious of any online pharmacy that: doesn't require you to send a prescription, doesn't talk to your doctor to make sure your prescription is valid, doesn't ask you to do more than fill out an online questionnaire, doesn't have the free number and street addresses listed on its website, doesn't make pharmacists available to answer questions about medications. Be on the lookout, too, if the site only sells lifestyle medications like drugs for impotence, obesity or pain. Greece, the home of Hippocrates and Asclepius, is a country of pharmacies, and every city The size has one. Cities will have plenty, with some assigned to stay open all night. If the pharmacy is closed, the door notification will give the address of the nearest pharmacy scheduled to open that day. Greek pharmacies can be seen with a green equine armed cross, either illuminated in the neo or on a white background. Many medicines that require prescriptions in the United States are sold over the counter in Greece, usually at a fraction of the price paid in North America. Remember, however, bringing home drugs from Greece can cause problems at U.S. customs if you don't have prescriptions for them. If you are looking for something specific, having a generic or real name medication can help you find the Greek equivalent easier. Pharmacists are usually very decent diagnosticians and speak English. They can help you with many medical problems and can be your first line of defense if you feel sick in Greece. If you have a problem but are hesitant to go through the process of meeting a real doctor or visiting a foreign emergency room on your trip, pop into your local pharmacy and see what they say. After all, you may not need this meeting. In an emergency, ask the hotel staff or call the tourist police for advice from English-speaking doctors in your area. Pharmacies also have a wide range of Greek products for health and beauty, and visiting them can be fun viewing time. They often carry products made with special Greek ingredients, a line or two of essential oils, as well as vitamins and other revolutionary remedies. Because of the oddities in the Greek health care system, these over-the-counter items can cost much more than prescription drugs. Large pharmacies will have active sales staff in white robes standing to help you; You don't have to wander up the shelves without someone in close attendance, so unobtrusively choosing that a box of sanitary napkins or a nose hair clipper is usually out of the question. Before we turn to the pros and cons of online pharmacies, we need to distinguish between the types of pharmacies. Pharmacy Benefit Managers (PBMs) are companies that negotiate prices with drug manufacturers. They work on behalf of insurance companies to get the lowest costs for prescription drugs. These drugs are then added to the health plans under this insurer's formula. The goal is to get both you and the insurer the best deal.
