contestants, known as co-workers, live together in a specially built house that is isolated from the outside world. Housemates are continuously monitored during their stay at home by live TV cameras as well as personal audio microphones. Throughout the competition, housemates are evicted from the house - voted out of competition. The last remaining
housemate wins the competition and receives a cash prize. The series takes its name from the character in George Orwell's 1949 novel Nineteen Eighty-Four. The series also featured a 24-hour live broadcast, in which fans could watch inside the house
at any time. Big Brother aired for eleven series on Channel 4, followed by one last special edition, Ultimate Big Brother, which ended on September 10, 2011. [5] In 2014, Emma Willis announced that the show would return to a sixteenth series in 2015.
It was announced on March 19, 2015 that the show would remain on the air until at least 2018. [6] The show was initially hosted by Davina McCall from its inception until its cancellation on Channel 4. Although he was offered the position of host after the show's move to Channel 5, McCall decided not to return. Former winner Brian Dowling became the host,
a position he held during the twelfth and thirteenth series. [7] Emma Willis later replaced Dowling as the host of the fourteenth series series onwards. [8] Marcus Bentley has the narrator of the series since it premiered in 2000. Big Brother, which is a shorter version the main

[15] Following the show's success, it was confirmed that editions for the United Kingdom and the United States were under construction.
[16] In March 2000, it was revealed that the series would be broadcast on Channel 4 and E4. [17] Casting for the series premiered on July 18, 2000, and ended when teammate Craig Phillips was crowned the winner after 64 days in the House. [20] The series
proved to be a success early in its career, which led to a second series. [21] Big Brother 2 premiered on May 25, 2001, and continued to have the success of the previous series premiered on May 24, 2002, and was the first series to perform a live
