North East Acceptance Rate: How Hard Is It to Get In? Like many universities, Northeastern is becoming increasingly competitive to get into. In 1978, Northeastern extended its acceptance offer to nearly 80% of its collection of applicants. By 2018, the acceptance rate at Northeastern has shrunk to just 19%. This steady decline in acceptance rates as the number of applications has increased steadily. In 2018, Northeaster received more than 62,000 applications, marking an increase of nearly 8,000 from the previous year. Luckily, applying to Northeastern doesn't need to be a shot in the dark. There are things you can do to significantly increase your chances. So, how can someone get east? First of all, know what the basic requirements and expectations are. Northeastern requires all applicants to have finished high school for at least four years of English, two years of two years of the same foreign language, three years of science, and three years of mathematics. In addition to being well prepared academically, successful Northeastern applicants typically excel in standardized tests. The mid-50% of students accepted for autumn 2018 received SAT scores between 1470-1550, or ACT scores between 33-35. They also received a high school GPA of between 4.1 and 4.5. Discuss your Recommendations with your Teacher first. It's always a good idea to make sure that your recommendations complete the rest of your application. What if Rejected? It's always disappointing to be rejected, no matter the circumstances, but being rejected from college can be a very bitter pill to swallow. At Northeastern, more than four out of every five applications end up being rejected, so at least you know you're not alone. Before you get too down, consider your options. First of all, yes—Northeastern does accept transfer students. They ask you to wait a full academic year before reapply and recommend that transfer applicants hold at least a 3.3 college GPA, although all applications will be considered holistic. However, you should be aware that your chances of entering as a transfer student are not much better than entering as a first-year student. The acceptance rate for transfer students in 2018 is 26%. That being said, we at CollegeVine never recommend that you go to college aged the first year you intend to transfer elsewhere, unless you start at a community college or have other exceptional circumstances.
