For many computer users, filling out PDF forms and PDF documents is commonplace, and the Mac Preview app makes it easy and quick to fill out a PDF file. The great thing about using a preview to complete a FORM PDF on a Mac is that there are no additional apps or downloads needed, it is included in every version of Mac OS and Mac OS X system software. Regardless of the type of PDF file, if it has forms to fill out you will be able to complete the document and save it, ready for any use you need. This tutorial will focus on demonstrating how to fill out PDF forms on the Mac, but for mobile users you can also fill out PDF documents on the iPhone and iPad easily too. As you fill out PDF Forms on Mac with a preview We're going to assume that you have a PDF form document ready that should be filled out if so: Open the PDF document you want to fill out in the Preview app on Mac if the PDF file is online go ahead and save it locally first click on each of the form fields available in the PDF file and fill out each form of the area as needed Review the PDF document To make sure it's completed and all the necessary forms are sufficiently filled out when satisfied, go to the File menu and select Save, Export, or Save both - note that save overwrites the existing PDF file and save as will make the completed version as a copy of the original PDF file That's it! The PDF file has been filled and you can use it as needed, attach it to your email, upload it to the website, print it out, regardless of your next step. If you feel like it, you can confirm the PDF was filled successfully by opening or using a quick glance at the PDF file to see it being completed with all forms filled out. Note that previews should be the default PDF view on mac, although some third-party apps may try to change that. You can easily change the preview back to the viewer's default PDF though if necessary. What if the PDF form requires a signature? Many forms of PDF and PDF applications may require a signature. Guess what? A preview app can help you sign a document as well! There are actually two different methods to place a signature on the PDF files on the Mac, you can sign the documents using the Mac Trackpad as described here, and you can also place digital signatures through the camera in the preview as described here. It's wildly useful, but it's not just the Mac that has the ability to sign, iPhone and iPad users will find iOS has a signature feature too. Pdf forms don't work as I can use Mac filling out the PDF document anyway? Most PDF forms can be filled easily, as described above. However, sometimes you may encounter a PDF file that has no forms that allow text input or data entry, and instead is basically an image file that is stored as a PDF that otherwise looks like a document or or Don't worry if the PDF file doesn't contain interactive forms that are easy to fill out as described above because you can still fill out a PDF form using Mac Preview Text tools to add text to PDF files, photos or image files as described here. Another option is to fill out the PDF using iOS Markup Text tools too. So don't worry, you'll still be able to fill out this PDF document and use it. Can I fill out a PDF file directly from my email to Mac? Yes, if you're using the Mac Mail app and you have a state-of-the-art mac OS software, you can use Mail Markup to annotate attachments, including PDF files, directly from email. This is a good and quick option if someone sent you a PDF file that you want to quickly return to them, but note that the email markup won't save a copy of the PDF file to your local default computer.
