Abdominal pain, discomfort and shortness of breath: These problems can occur when too much fluid is created in the abdominal cavity. This may limit the patient's ability to eat, walk and perform daily activities. Infection: Fluids that accumulate in the intestines as a result of ascites can become infected with bacteria. When this occurs, the condition is called spontaneous bacterial peritonitis. It usually causes fever and abdominal pain. The diagnosis is usually made by taking a sample from the abdominal cavity, as described above (i.e., performing paracentesis). Spontaneous bacterial peritonitis is a serious disease that requires antibiotic treatment IV. After recovery from this infection, long-term treatment with oral antibiotics is necessary to keep the infection from recurring. Fluid in the lungs: This condition is called hepatic hydrothorax. The abdominal fluid fills the lungs (mostly on the right side). This leads to shortness of breath, cough, hypoxemia (lack of oxygen in the blood) and/or discomfort in the chest. Hepatic hydrothorax is best treated by removing abdominal ascites with paracentesis. Renal failure: Worsening cirrhosis of the liver can lead to kidney failure. This condition is called hepatorenal syndrome. It is rare but is a serious condition and can lead to kidney failure. Limit the amount of salt in your diet. The most important step towards the treatment of ascites is a sharp reduction in salt intake. The recommended limits are 2,000 mg or less per day. Seeing a nutrition specialist (dietitian) is helpful, especially because the salt content in foods is difficult to determine. Salt substitutes that do not contain potassium can be used. Often, patients will require diuretics (water pills) to treat ascites. Take these pills as prescribed. Common diuretics are spironolactone (Aldactone®) and/or furosemide (Lasix®). These water tablets can cause problems with electrolytes (sodium, potassium) and kidney function (creatinine). Taking water tablets is not a substitute for reducing salt intake. Both are needed for the treatment of ascites. Other, increasingly aggressive treatments include: Paracentesis as a treatment: Sometimes fluids continue to grow in the abdominal cavity despite the use of diuretics and a limited salt diet. In these cases, patients may need a paracentesis to remove this large amount of excess Surgery: Surgical placement of a shunt (tube) between the main vein (port wine vein) and small veins is sometimes used as a treatment. The radiologist may directly through the liver, thereby relieving portal hypertension and reducing ascites. By increasing blood flow, all organs of the body are better able to perform their function. Ascites refers to fluid that accumulates in the abdominal cavity. Although ascites are most common in patients with cirrhosis of the liver and as a result of portal hypertension (approximately 85% of cases), 7% to 10% of patients with ascites develop secondary in relation to malignancies.1 The most common malignancies associated with the development of ascites include colorectal cancer, ovaries, breasts, pancreas, pancreas, pancreas, liver, and lymphoma.2 Approximately 50% of patients with malignant ascites have peritoneal carcinomatosis with an additional 13% of patients having extensive liver metastases as a result of portal hypertension.2 Malignant ascites can develop through several mechanisms: blocked lymphatic channels as a result of malignancy, direct production of fluid in the abdominal cavity by high cancer activity, and when functional cirrhosis develops in patients with extensive hepatic metastases leading to portal hypertension. These patients may have similar physical examination results for those with cirrhotics, including spider angioma, stretched umbilical veins (caput medusae), scler icterus, jaundice, anascake, and stretched stomach. On closer inspection of the abdominal cavity, patients with malignant ascites may have increased dullness to or bias of dullness. Patients may complain of increased abdominal girth, generalized abdominal pain and shortness of breath. Weight loss is a relatively non-specific symptom, but may be more common than with underlying malignancy. Abdominal ultrasound can be performed for the presence of ascites in the abdominal cavity. When ascites is tested, patients can undergo paracentesis in order to remove the ascites fluid for analysis. These studies can be used to evaluate the patient for both infectious and non-cancer etiology of ascitic fluid. The absolute amount of neutrophils (ANC) of 250 cells/mm3 or more indicates spontaneous bacterial peritonitis (SBP) and is usually treated with antibiotics such as ceftriaxone.
